Colossians Bible Study – Colossians 2:18-23 & 3:1-3

Lesson #12

**INSTRUCTIONS: Read the entire section of Scripture in Colossians before starting to look up the other Scripture verses and filling in the blanks. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding as you read God's word.
(Most Scriptures used are from the New King James Version)

18-19 **Let no one DEFRAUD you of your REWARD**, taking delight in **false humility and WORSHIP of ANGELS**, intruding into those **things which he has not seen, VAINLY PUFFED UP by his FLESHLY MIND**, and not **holding fast to the Head**, from which all the body, nourished and knit together by joints and ligaments, grows with the increase which is from God.

• **Revelation 3:11** “Behold, I come quickly! _____ fast what you _____, that _____ may _____ your _____ (reward).”

Definition: “Let no one DEFRAUD you of your REWARD” – Defraud means to **take away or hold back your rights; to cheat you of something that is rightfully yours**. This is so sad, because it is exactly what Satan tries to do to some Christians. If he can't get a Christian to fall into some flagrant sin, then he tries to get them involved in legalism and works of the flesh. **What Is the BASIS for REWARDS in HEAVEN for Believers? The BASIS for REWARDS is obedience to God's commands**, and what He considers “good works,” but **God sees what MOTIVE is behind the works we do**, and that inner motive and attitude of the heart is as important as the outward deed. Deuteronomy 28:47 says the Israelites were under the curse not only because of their disobedience, but **because they “did not serve God with joy and a glad heart”** and their attitude was wrong. Any “good works” done with wrong motives, or “in the flesh” and NOT by the power of the Holy Spirit, are “wood, hay, and straw” - no rewards!

• **I Corinthians 3:12-15** “Now if anyone _____ on this _____ with gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw, each one's _____ will become manifest; for the Day (of judgment) will declare it, because it will be _____ by _____; and the fire will _____ each one's _____, of what _____ it is. If anyone's _____ which he has _____ on it (*on the foundation of Christ*) endures, he will _____ a _____. If anyone's _____ is burned, he will suffer _____; but he _____ will be _____, yet so as through fire.”

Definition: “False humility and WORSHIP of ANGELS” – False humility is pretty much self-explanatory: these people are hypocrites, and are **pretending to be humble before God**, but they are really prideful and focusing on their own agenda. As for “worship of angels”, the word of God is very clear that **ANGELS SHOULD NOT BE WORSHIPED! Angels are CREATED beings**, not gods, and they are either serving God, or the fallen angels are serving their master, Satan. We are **NOT to worship or be caught up in GIVING TOO MUCH ATTENTION to angels** of any kind.

Definition: “VAINLY PUFFED UP by his FLESHLY MIND” – The Bible tells us that there will be a falling away from the True Faith in the end times, and indicates that **false prophets and prophetesses** are IN the CHURCH, as well as outside the church in false cults and religions. We must be very careful NOT to get caught up in running to this or that “prophet” or “prophetess” for advice and answers. These people are **“VAINLY PUFFED UP by their FLESHLY MINDS” and they are NOT getting their messages from**

God. God has given us His word, and **He has told us to PRAY and not “lose heart”** or give up too soon. Because **many Christians want a “QUICK FIX” answer to their situations, they are not willing to study God’s word, and to pray and wait upon the Lord for the answer.** They go instead to people within the church who will **give them “a word”** about their particular situation. This becomes no better than going to psychics and fortunetellers! These **false prophets and prophetesses** give “flattering words” to “deceive the hearts of the simple,” they put “stumbling blocks” before God’s people, **cause divisions in the church,** and eventually cause God’s people to commit acts of immorality.”

20-22 Therefore, **if you DIED with CHRIST from the BASIC PRINCIPLES of the WORLD,** why, as though living in the world, do you **SUBJECT yourselves to regulations** – “Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle,” which all **concern things which PERISH with the USING** – **according to the COMMANDMENTS and DOCTRINES of MEN?**

Definition: “Things which PERISH with the USING – according to the COMMANDMENTS and DOCTRINES of MEN?” – But wait a minute! I thought these false teachers were trying to impose the Law of Moses on the Christians, and wasn’t that God’s Law? Yes, for the time that God set up the Law through Moses, it was His Law, but **now God Himself has changed His order of dealing with mankind,** and we are under the New Covenant in Jesus Christ. That means whoever NOW tries to follow the Law

of Moses is doing it as if it were **“COMMANDMENTS and DOCTRINES of MEN.”** **God is NO LONGER endorsing the Mosaic Law,** He has set it aside in order to deal with men through His Son Jesus Christ. We are NO LONGER UNDER the LAW! As for **“basic principles of the world,”** in Colossians 2:8 & 20, it means the basic, worldly rituals of man-made religion - people trying to reach God through a human system of works. Jewish believers, **BEFORE they were SAVED, were like SLAVES** under the Hebrew rituals. Gentile believers were **“slaves” to their HEATHEN GODS and goddesses,** and every false religious system out there in the world puts people in BONDAGE. **Paul WARNS Christian Believers NOT to put themselves back under that kind of BONDAGE of RELIGIOUS RITUALS** and regulations (commandments), whether Jewish or Gentile religion.

Definition: “Beware lest anyone CHEAT you through PHILOSOPHY” – Paul is continuing his warning against false teachers that began in the previous verses. The word here for “philosophy” is the same word for “religion” in the Greek. These would be **religious ideas NOT depending on Jesus Christ and what He did on the cross. These would be MAN-MADE RELIGIONS and traditions.** Most of the religious cults today try to tell you that you’re missing out on something by not following their religious “philosophies” and ideas. They try to tell you Jesus Christ is not enough, or the Bible is not enough.

Definition: “Empty DECEIT” and “According to the TRADITION of MEN” – Jesus had a lot to say about the Pharisees and others who followed man-made religious traditions instead of following the word of God. This is still a problem in the world today, and many churches have been infiltrated and ruined by false teachers who have come in, and no one stopped them. **The words “empty deceit” are also translated as VANITY in some Bible translations, and Paul calls them “vain babblings”** in I Timothy 6:20. Vanity is something **VAIN and worthless, EMPTY.**

23 These things indeed have an **APPEARANCE of WISDOM** in **self-imposed religion**, false humility, and **neglect of the body**, but are of **NO VALUE against the INDULGENCE of the FLESH**.

Definition: “NO VALUE against the INDULGENCE of the FLESH” – These MAN-MADE or “self-imposed RELIGIONS” are of “NO VALUE against the INDULGENCE of the FLESH.” Our sinful flesh cannot be changed permanently by outwardly imposed rules and regulations. Yes, we need laws and rules in our society to help keep sinful man under control, but in the sense of controlling our passions and lusts in a godly fashion, and **for Christians to become more like Jesus Christ, we need MORE than just rules and regulations. We need the TRANSFORMING POWER of the Holy Spirit** to discipline our flesh and make us holy.

Definition: “BAPTIZED into Christ Jesus” “BAPTIZED into His DEATH” — The word “baptized” in the Greek means IMMERSED, PLACED INTO, IDENTIFIED WITH. **We are PLACED INTO CHRIST** the moment we believe, by the Holy Spirit, as well as the Holy Spirit coming to live in us. Because **we are IN CHRIST**, and **CHRIST ALREADY DIED to sin**, then **WE HAVE DIED to sin**, too.

Definition: “Your LIFE is HIDDEN with CHRIST in GOD” – What a precious promise! We are not left on our own to struggle with living the Christian life. We are PLACED IN CHRIST, and **His Holy Spirit dwells in us to give us His power to live for him.**
