Definition: "These are SONS of GOD" - We BECOME sons of God, or CHILDREN OF GOD by FAITH in JESUS CHRIST, but we PROVE TO OTHERS that we ARE children of God by **ALLOWING the Holy Spirit to LEAD, GUIDE and DIRECT our lives**. This comes with MATURITY, as we GROW in our walk with Christ. In fact, the Greek word used here for "sons" means **ADULT, FULL GROWN CHILDREN**. When we are first BORN AGAIN (also called being "BORN of God"), we are little BABIES. We are just as much children of God then, but we are still in the BABY STATE, and do NOT always ALLOW the HOLY SPIRIT TO LEAD US.

Definition: "LED by the Spirit" - This is basically the same and interchangeable with BEING FILLED with the SPIRIT. We are to ALLOW the Holy Spirit to LEAD us as we YIELD and give CONTROL of our lives to Him. Also, remember that the Holy Spirit never PUSHES or DRIVES us, but **He WAITS UNTIL WE GIVE HIM the CONTROL** of our lives.

Definition: "Jesus was LED by the SPIRIT" - Why did Jesus, who was PERFECT, who was God in the Flesh, have to be "filled with the Spirit" and led by the Spirit? The reason is because He LAID ASIDE His powers and privileges as God (see Phil 2:5-11) when He came to Earth as a HUMAN. Jesus never lost His NATURE of CHARACTER as

God, but **He limited Himself** to have only HUMAN resources while on Earth. **We have those SAME RESOURCES through the Holy Spirit.** Jesus is our EXAMPLE, and we see that He was CONTROLLED and EMPOWERED by the HOLY SPIRIT, just as we can be!

- **Ephesians 5:17-18** "Therefore do not be _____, but understand what the _____ of the LORD is. And do not be _____ with wine, in which is dissipation; but be _____ with the _____."

Definition: "FILLED with the SPIRIT" - Paul contrasts BEING DRUNK with BEING FILLED with the Spirit. INSTEAD of being drunk, which is to be "UNDER THE INFLUENCE" of alcohol, we are to be "UNDER THE INFLUENCE," or CONTROLLED by the **Holy Spirit**. This is NOT a ONE-TIME experience, but a continuous YIELDING of ourselves to the Holy Spirit's control in our lives. The literal translation of the Greek is "keep being CONTINUALLY FILLED" with the Spirit.

Definition: "SPIRIT of ADOPTION" - ADOPTION had a different meaning to the Romans than it does for us. The Romans would have a ceremony when a child reached ADULTHOOD. This public ceremony declared that the child was officially an adult, with all the RIGHTS and PRIVILEGES of an ADULT, responsible for his own actions, and also that he was UNABLE TO BE DISINHERITED. What does this mean for us? It means that we are BORN into God's family as a little BABY, but we are ADOPTED and GIVEN ADULT STANDING as well. This POSITION IN CHRIST is ours for eternity, **we are UNABLE TO BE DISINHERITED**. Nothing or **NO ONE can take us away** or "snatch" us away from God once we are BORN INTO HIS FAMILY.

- **Read John 10:27-30** "My Sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they _____ Me. And I give them _____, and they shall never perish; neither shall anyone _____ them out of My _____. Definition: "By whom we cry out, 'ABBA, FATHER' " - Abba means "Papa" or "Daddy" in the Aramaic language. This **INTIMATE relationship with God** is only possible through faith in Jesus Christ, and by the Holy Spirit living in our heart. If you did not have a good relationship with your Earthly father, you can now have a **WARM AND LOVING RELATIONSHIP with God** as the "Daddy" you never had.

Definition: "SPIRIT of BONDAGE again to FEAR" - The Old Testament Law was BONDAGE, as is any kind of RELIGION that tells people they must BE GOOD ENOUGH for God to accept them (salvation by WORKS). This produces FEAR, because we KNOW we can **NEVER be GOOD ENOUGH**.

Definition: "The SPIRIT Himself BEARS WITNESS" - "Bear witness" means to TESTIFY of GIVE EVIDENCE. The Holy Spirit, who is a PERSON, not an "it" (He is God Himself), TESTIFIES to us and CONFIRMS TO OUR HEARTS that we are really and truly His children. He ASSURES US that we belong to Him, and helps us understand (comprehend) HOW MUCH GOD LOVES US.

Definition: "JOINT HEIRS with Christ" - An HEIR is one who will inherit or receive some endowment, property or quality from a PARENT. We are God's children, so we are also His HEIRS. JOINT HEIRS means **we will INHERIT EQUALLY with Jesus.**
