Definition: “You also will APPEAR with Him in GLORY” – When it says, **“When Christ who is our LIFE APPEARS”**, this **“APPEARING”** means His second coming, or the return of Jesus Christ to the earth to judge all evil and set up His kingdom. Scripture tells us that **WE, as His saints and true Believers, will return with Him from heaven.** Praise the Lord!

Definition: “GLORY which shall be REVEALED in us” — When the whole church of Jesus Christ is gathered in heaven, we will receive our rewards at the Judgment Seat of Christ, we will partake of the Marriage Supper of the Lamb, and we will be REVEALED to all of CREATION as being the high point and **CULMINATION of God’s grace.** **All the saints and angels will worship God and give Him GLORY** for His marvelous grace and mercy which He has shown to us by saving us and giving us eternal life with Him. We will also **RULE and REIGN** with Jesus Christ.

Definition: “Your MEMBERS which are on the earth” — Individual parts of the BODY, such as HANDS, FEET, TONGUE, EYES, etc. I believe the MIND (brain) could also be considered a “member” of the body. We have the POWER to **CHOOSE to let our BODY** and its parts (including our mind) be used for the glory of God, as **His INSTRUMENTS or TOOLS** of righteousness, or as INSTRUMENTS or TOOLS for sin. As it relates to addictions, we might think of what and how much food, chemicals or alcohol we allow to go into our MOUTH; or do we allow our EYES to look at pornography? Are the **things we are doing with our BODY** glorifying to God? Romans 6:13 says, to **“PRESENT yourselves to God”** and **“Present your MEMBERS as INSTRUMENTS of righteousness to God.”** This is also a DAILY decision, a **DAILY CHOICE**, sometimes even a **MOMENT BY MOMENT CHOICE, of DECIDING whether you will PRESENT YOUR BODY to God**, or to your addiction, compulsive behavior or other sin. **HOW do we “PUT TO DEATH” the deeds of the BODY? — BY THE SPIRIT!!** By the POWER of the HOLY SPIRIT in our lives, we **PRESENT our BODIES** as a SACRIFICE to God. NOT a sacrifice of DYING for Christ, but as a LIVING SACRIFICE. Be willing to PLACE ON THE ALTAR those things that DO NOT PLEASE GOD, and COMPLETELY, TOTALLY **SURRENDER your BODY to God**, for His USE, and LIVE your life for HIM BY THE POWER OF THE HOLY SPIRIT.

• **Romans 12:1-2** “I beseech you therefore brethren, by the mercies of God, that you

Definition: “FORNICATION, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and COVETOUSNESS” –God’s word uses the terms **ADULTERY and FORNICATION, which means ANY sexual intercourse other than between a man and woman MARRIED to each other.** Some of the newer Bible versions translate “fornication” as “sexual immorality,” but it is the same word in the Greek: “**porneia.**” There are a lot of “modern” terms that we use for certain sexual behaviors, such as homosexual, heterosexual, pedophile, pornography, etc., which are not in the Bible. The reason they are not mentioned in the Bible **by those terms** is because those are modern, recently-made-up terms, and they were not in common use in the English language when the Bible was translated. All of those behaviors would fall under the category of **ADULTERY and FORNICATION** (see Leviticus 18 for more detail, including what constitutes incest). There is one more term, **UNCLEANNES**S, which refers to all the other types of sexual activity, whether they involve actual sexual intercourse or not. In other words, the **THOUGHTS** a person has that are sexually related, and also what our modern society calls “making out.” I Corinthians 6:18-20 tells us to “**FLEE sexual immorality,**” which means **RUN AWAY from it.** II Corinthians 6:17-18 & 7:1 tells us to **separate ourselves** from ANYTHING UNCLEAN, and to walk in holiness and reverence to God.

Definition: “The WRATH of GOD is coming upon the SONS of DISOBEDIENCE” — **“The WRATH of GOD”** is God’s **ANGER** against **SIN** — the **PUNISHMENT** that **WE DESERVE** for violating God’s laws and falling short of His perfect standards. **“The SONS of DISOBEDIENCE”** means the **UNSAVED**, those who have **NOT** put their trust in Jesus Christ as their Savior. According to Ephesians 2:2, the “sons of disobedience” are **UNBELIEVERS**; those who are still under Satan’s control, and **have NOT been born again.** In Ephesians 2:3 they are also called **“children of WRATH.”** Since they have **NOT** accepted God’s way of forgiveness for their sins, **they have NOTHING to look forward to except the WRATH OF GOD and eternity in HELL.**

Definition: “YOU also ONCE WALKED when you LIVED in THEM” – This refers to the things of verse 5, the “fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry.” These are all the sins we “walked” in, or **lived our lives in, before we were saved**. God has delivered us out of that world now, and we should NOT fall back into those sinful ways of living anymore.

• **Ephesians 4:17-18** “This I say therefore, and testify in the Lord, that you should _____ longer _____ as the rest of the Gentiles walk, in the futility of their mind, having their understanding darkened, being alienated from the life of God, because of the _____ that is in them, because of the hardening of their heart:”

Definition: “FUTILITY OF THEIR MINDS” – The emptiness and stupidity of their minds; **not thinking right**, not able to understand the things of God.

Definition: “No longer WALK as the rest of the Gentiles” – Paul is speaking to born-again Christians here, and telling them NOT to CONTINUE to LIVE THEIR LIVES or BEHAVE like **non-Christians**. He especially tells them **NOT to THINK like unbelievers**.

• **Psalms 1:1** “Blessed is the man who _____ in the counsel of (taking advice from) the _____, nor stands in the path of (“hangs out” with) _____, nor sits in the seat of (has fellowship with) the _____ (those who ridicule and reject God).”
