Here's a sample of how you might pray this prayer of Paul's for yourself;

Father God, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, I ask You to GIVE UNTO ME: the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of You; [that] the eyes of MY understanding would be enlightened; that I may know what is the hope of **YOUR calling for ME,** and what are the riches of the glory of MY inheritance in the saints; and what is the exceeding greatness of YOUR power toward ME, because I believe, according to the working of YOUR mighty power. Thank you, Lord.

What does "the hope of **His calling**" mean? It means that **God has a plan for your life,** but that plan is based **entirely on His calling and choosing you** by His grace, **not** based on any works of goodness or intelligence of your own!! (See Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:3-7)

- Read II Timothy 1:8-9 (Verse 9) "Who has saved us and _____ us with a holy **CALLING, not** according to _____ , but according to **His own purpose** and **grace** which was GIVEN to us in Christ Jesus before time began."

- Read Romans 8:28-31 "For whom He **foreknew**, him He also PREDESTINATED **to be conformed to the image of** _____ , that He (Jesus) might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover, whom He predestined, these He also _____ , whom **HE called**, these He also _____ , and whom He justified, these He also _____ ."
- I Corinthians 1:26-29 "For you see your _____ , brethren, that not many _____ are **CALLED**. But God has **chosen** the _____ things of the world to put to shame the wise, and **God has chosen** the _____ things of the world to put to _____ the things which are mighty; and the base things of the world, and the things which are _____ God has _____ , (Verse 29) That no flesh (no human being) should glory in His _____ ."

- Ephesians 3:17 "That Christ may **dwelt in your hearts** by _____"
- I John 3:23-24 "And this is His commandment, that we should believe on the name of **His Son Jesus Christ**, and love one another as He gave commandment. And he that keeps His commandments dwells in _____ , and He in him. And by this we know that **He (dwells) abides in us**, by the _____ whom He has given us."
