Definition: "What shall we DO, that we may WORK" - Man in his SINFUL, PRIDEFUL nature is **always looking for SOMETHING TO DO** in order to earn salvation. Man in his fallen nature has **wanted to DO his own thing to EARN God's approval** ever since Cain and Abel, and **God has been REJECTING man's own efforts** ever since He rejected Cain's sacrifice (Genesis 4:3-7). Both Old Testament and New Testament are full of incidents, examples, and warnings **against trying by our HUMAN EFFORT or "works" to win God's approval.**

Definition: "DEAD WORKS" - These are **religious works or good deeds** done in the **power of the FLESH**, and a person who is **operating in their FLESH**, and not in FAITH and the POWER of the HOLY SPIRIT, **CANNOT DO ANYTHING** that will be **pleasing to God** (Romans 8:8). Hebrews 9:14 calls these works "dead" and Isaiah 64:6 calls them "filthy rags." This applies BOTH to those who are **not BORN AGAIN** (therefore they are "of the FLESH" only - see John 3:6), and to those Christians who do so-called good deeds with carnal and selfish motives.

Definition: "MANNA" - The name "manna" simply means "what is it?" It was not a natural substance or food, but SUPERNATURAL (not of the earth), therefore God called it bread from heaven.

32-33. Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **Moses did NOT** give you the BREAD FROM HEAVEN, but **My Father gives you the TRUE bread from heaven.** For the bread of God is **He who comes down from heaven and gives LIFE** to the world."

Definition: "Moses did NOT give you the BREAD from HEAVEN" - First of all, Moses did not give the manna, but **God gave it.** Secondly, the "manna" or "bread from heaven" that God gave to the Israelites was a PICTURE of JESUS CHRIST as the TRUE bread from heaven, which gives ETERNAL LIFE.

34-36. Then they said to Him, "Lord, give us this bread always." And Jesus said to them, "**I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE.** He who comes to Me **shall never hunger**, and **he who believes in Me shall never thirst.** But I said to you that you have seen Me and yet do not believe.

Definition: "I AM THE BREAD OF LIFE" - In the Gospel of John, Jesus makes many statements where He uses the "I AM" - the name of God. These names or titles for Jesus correspond with the names of God in the Old Testament. When Moses asked God in the burning bush to give him a name to tell the people, God simply said, "I AM THAT I AM" (Exodus 3:13-14). In other places in the Bible, God would say "I AM" and then add to His name whatever it was you needed. For example, "I AM the God who heals you" (Exodus 15:26) or "I AM the Provider" (Genesis 22:14). Jesus does the SAME THING. He says "I AM" and adds to it whatever we need in a spiritual sense: "I AM the Bread of Life," "I AM the Door," "I AM the Resurrection and the Life," "I AM the Light of the World," "I AM the Vine."

Definition: "RAISE him up at the LAST DAY" - This is a PROMISE of the RESURRECTION of the BODY, and a PROMISE of our ETERNAL SECURITY in Jesus. **Jesus has the ability to KEEP US SAFE until the VERY END.** We have the PROMISE of having NEW, PERFECT resurrection bodies, just like Jesus' resurrection body, for all eternity.

Definition: "The WILL of the FATHER" - The will of the Father is to BELIEVE in the Son, but the word "believe" in the Bible means more than just mental knowledge. The Amplified translation says the one who **"believes in, cleaves to, trusts in and relies on"** Jesus will be saved. Believe so that **ALL your trust and reliance is on Jesus.**
