Definition: "And it was NIGHT" -- It was actual nighttime when Judas left, but this is also SYMBOLIC of **Judas' SPIRITUAL STATE**, in that he was in absolute spiritual darkness. Every unbeliever is in DARKNESS, but the believer in Christ is **NOT in darkness**. We know from verse 27 that, "after the piece of bread, **Satan ENTERED him**," so we know that Judas was in the deepest darkness possible, being indwelt by **the Prince of Darkness** himself.

Definition: "The Son of Man is GLORIFIED" and "God is GLORIFIED in Him" -- God the Father was about to be glorified in God the Son, as Jesus would voluntarily give His life to redeem mankind from sin. This was God's plan from all eternity, so **the**

FULFILLMENT of His plan would bring GLORY and PRAISE to God. Notice in the Scriptures below the phrases "according to the eternal purpose" and "ordained before the ages" and "mystery." The word "mystery" in the New Testament means something that was hidden or not revealed in the Old Testament.

Definition: "If you have LOVE for ONE ANOTHER" -- The "distinguishing mark" or primary PROOF that we are truly disciples of Jesus is if we LOVE one ANOTHER. All the claims of faith and all the correct doctrine are basically worthless **if we do not have LOVE** for one another in the Body of Christ. If you only TALK the TALK, but do not WALK the WALK, you are just making a lot of noise, and it means nothing.

- **I Corinthians 13:1-3** "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have not _____, I have become as sounding (noisy) brass or a clanging cymbal. And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all _____, so that I could remove mountains, but have not _____, I am _____. And though I bestow (give) all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned (become a martyr), but have not _____ it profits me _____."

Jesus answered him, "**Where I am going you cannot follow Me now, but you shall follow Me afterward.**" Peter said to Him, "Lord, why can I not follow You now? I will lay down my life for Your sake." Jesus answered him, "Will you lay down your life for My sake? Most assuredly, I say to you, the rooster shall not crow **till you have denied Me three times.**"

Definition: "Where I am GOING, you CANNOT follow Me NOW" -- Jesus will be going back to heaven, into the very presence of God the Father. They cannot follow Him now, but they will be able to follow Him to heaven later. By His death and resurrection, **Jesus opened up the WAY to heaven** for everyone who will believe in Him, and He has MADE our RESERVATIONS for us to be with Him in heaven!

- **I Peter 1:3-4** "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the _____ of Jesus Christ from the _____, to an _____ incorruptible and undefiled, and that does not fade away, _____ in _____ for you."

Definition: "Till you have DENIED Me THREE TIMES" -- Poor Peter! He loved Jesus, and truly felt he would stand by Jesus through whatever would happen. But **Peter was relying on his own strength** to do it, and he failed miserably. We also fail to live up to what the Lord expects of us if we try to do it in our own strength, instead of in the POWER of the Holy Spirit.

Definition: "You BELIEVE in God, BELIEVE ALSO IN ME" -- Here is just another statement of Jesus showing that He is EQUAL to God the Father. Otherwise, what a colossal ego to say to us that we can believe in Him with the same confidence that we believe in God! If Jesus were not truly God the Son, God in the flesh, He could not say such a thing, unless He were mentally deranged. Jesus is NOT just a good man and a prophet, or a great teacher. If He is not God incarnate (in the flesh), then He is nothing at all - you can't have it both ways!

2-6. "In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. **I go to PREPARE a PLACE for you.** And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will COME AGAIN and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also. And where I go you know, and the way you know." Thomas said to Him, 'Lord, **we do not know where You are going,** and how can we know the way?' Jesus said to him, "I AM THE WAY, THE TRUTH, and THE LIFE. NO ONE comes to the Father except THROUGH ME."

- **Matthew 25:34** "Then the King will say to those on His right hand, ' _____, you blessed of My _____, inherit the kingdom _____ for _____ from the foundation of the world.'"

Definition: "I GO to PREPARE a PLACE for YOU" -- What a blessed assurance to KNOW that Jesus is preparing a place for ME and for YOU in heaven! Jesus' disciples knew what He was referring to, because in the Jewish culture of that day, when a man wanted to marry a woman, he would first build an addition onto his father's house, and this would be where he would bring his new bride. Jesus is the Bridegroom, and the church is His bride, so He is going to His "Father's house" to prepare a place to receive His bride.

- **I John 5:13** "These things have I written unto you that _____ on the name of the Son of God; that you may _____ that you _____ eternal _____, and that you may _____ on the name of the Son of God."

Definition: "I will COME AGAIN and RECEIVE YOU to MYSELF" -- When a believer in Jesus Christ dies, you go directly into the presence of Jesus Himself in heaven. Paul says in II Corinthians 5:6-8, that if you are ABSENT from your earthly, physical body, you are PRESENT with the Lord. This means that your SPIRIT will leave your body at DEATH, and the physical body that gets buried in the ground, or burned up in a fire, or whatever happens to it, is only an empty shell. **Your spirit, the REAL YOU,** goes instantly to be with Jesus. Later, Jesus will come again, at the Resurrection Day, and your spirit will be reunited with your new RESURRECTION BODY that can live for eternity with God.

- **II Corinthians 5:6-8** "Therefore we are always confident, knowing that while we are at _____ in the _____ we are _____ from the Lord. For we walk by faith, not by sight. We are confident, yes, well pleased rather to be _____ from the _____ and to be _____ with the Lord."

Definition: "HOW can we KNOW the WAY?" -- The disciples did not realize that Jesus Himself IS the WAY to heaven. Many people today are also confused or blinded to the truth. They think that they can do good works, or religious rituals or ordinances, in order to get to heaven, and **they MISS the WAY,** because they do not **KNOW Jesus personally.**
