Favorite Psalms Bible Study - Part 1

Psalm 19:1-14 Lesson #3

****INSTRUCTIONS:** Read the entire section of Scripture in Psalms before starting to look up the other Scripture verses and filling in the blanks. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding as you read God's word. Most Scriptures are from the New King James Version.

1-6 **The HEAVENS DECLARE the GLORY of GOD; and the firmament shows His handiwork.** Day unto day utters speech, and night unto night reveals knowledge. **There is no SPEECH nor language where their VOICE is not heard. Their line has gone out through ALL the EARTH,** and their words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun, which like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, and rejoices like a strong man to run its race. **Its RISING is from one END of HEAVEN; and there is nothing hidden from its heat.**

Definition: “The HEAVENS DECLARE the GLORY of GOD; and the firmament shows His handiwork” – These verses are proclaiming the wonders of God's creation, especially the sun and the glories of the heavens. It is very poetic, comparing the sun to a bridegroom coming out of his chambers. When we look at a beautiful sunset or sunrise, we see some of the glory of God's creation, and we should give Him praise.

•**Psalm 148:1-6** “Praise the _____ from the _____; praise Him in the heights! _____ Him, all His angels; praise Him all His hosts! _____ Him, _____ and _____; praise Him all you _____ of _____! He has also established them forever and ever; He has made a decree which shall not pass away.”

Definition: “There is no SPEECH nor language where their VOICE is not heard. Their line has gone out through ALL the EARTH” – These verses show us the fact that **God's creation “speaks” to every living human being about God and who He is.** He is the creator of heaven and earth, the Almighty God, the all-powerful, all-knowing, wonderful creator of all things. **Recognizing that there is a creator is the FIRST STEP towards coming to know God.** It is not enough to just believe in a creator God, but it is a beginning. Years ago, there was a young boy in China who was in the Buddhist temple with his parents. He looked at the huge statue of Buddha, but then looked out the window and said, “God, who created the heavens and earth, You are too big to be contained in an idol's temple. I want to know who You are.” Years later, missionaries came to China and **brought the good news of Jesus Christ,** and this man became a Believer in Him. His thoughts as he looked out the window were heard by God the Father, and He sent people to give him the message about His Son, Jesus, and salvation through believing in Him. Of course, there are still many people who see the wonders of creation and either explain it away by teaching evolution, or they insist on worshiping idols, and saying that their idols created the world. Whatever reason they have for **REJECTING CHRIST, God's word says they have NO EXCUSE - they will be held responsible for their rejection of Jesus Christ,** because they had enough knowledge of God to ask for more, but they **CHOSE NOT TO.**

Definition: “Its RISING is from one END of HEAVEN; and there is nothing hidden from its heat” – We talk about the “rising” and “setting” of the sun, even though we know that it is really the earth traveling around the sun that makes it seem like it is rising and setting. This is the same kind of language here, because God certainly knows that it is the earth that revolves around the sun. In fact, in Isaiah 40:22, we see that **God sits upon the circle of the earth**, and the word “circle” actually means a globe or sphere, so we see that the Bible teaches a round, globe-shaped earth thousands of years before modern man “discovered” that the earth is round and not flat.

7-9 **The LAW of the LORD is PERFECT**, converting the soul; the testimony of the Lord is sure, **making WISE the SIMPLE; the STATUTES of the LORD are RIGHT**, rejoicing the heart; the commandment of the Lord is pure, enlightening the eyes; **the FEAR of the LORD is clean, enduring forever**; the judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.

Definition: “The LAW of the LORD is PERFECT” - “The STATUTES of the LORD are RIGHT” – This section of the Psalm is about how perfect, good and wonderful is God’s holy word. David, who wrote this Psalm, uses **the words “law of the Lord”, “statutes of the Lord”, “commandments”, “testimony” and “JUDGMENTS” which all mean the same thing - GOD’S WORD.** When it says that **God’s word is “CONVERTING the SOUL”**, this means it is God’s word that leads us to salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

Definition: "The FEAR of the LORD is clean" – The "Fear of the Lord" is mentioned many times in the word of God, especially in the Old Testament. It means **reverential AWE and RESPECT for God**, especially as EVIDENCED by OBEDIENCE to His commands and DOING His will. The New Testament equivalent is HOLY living, being filled with the Spirit, and "walking in a manner worthy of the Lord." Some people have trouble with the concept of FEARING God, because it seems like a negative thing, or has connotations of punishment or abuse from a parent in their childhood. If this is your case, whenever you see the words "fear of the Lord" or "fear God" just substitute "obedience to the Lord" and "OBEY God." Some people just don't like the idea of fearing God, because they want a "touchy-feely" religion, and want to think of God ONLY as a loving, indulgent Heavenly Father. Well, God IS a loving God, but He is not indulgent - **He practices "tough love."** There are negative consequences for disobeying God, just as there are positive consequences (blessings) for obeying God.

Definition: “By them Your SERVANT is WARNED” – God’s word, especially His commandments, not only tell us what we SHOULD do, but also **WARN US of what we SHOULD NOT do.** Paul tells us in I Corinthians 10:1-11, that the things the Israelites did when God punished them in the wilderness are **EXAMPLES** for us - not examples of what we should do, but **what we should NOT do.** Another word used in the Bible is **“ADMONITION”**, which means a GENTLE reproof, counsel or **WARNING of consequences of disobedience**; ENCOURAGEMENT and advice, especially in indicating **duties and obligations.**

•I Corinthians 10:6 & 11 “Now these things became our _____ to the intent that we _____ lust after _____ things as they also lusted.” (Vs. 11)

Definition: “CLEANSE me from secret FAULTS. Keep back Your servant also from PRESUMPTUOUS SINS” – **“Secret FAULTS”** are the things that we are not aware of, or are keeping hidden (although God knows about them, of course). **“PRESUMPTUOUS SINS” are those sins that we commit KNOWING FULL WELL what they are and that they are AGAINST God’s commandments, and yet we do them anyway.** As believers in Jesus, God promises to forgive our sins if we confess them to Him, but we also need to remember that to continue in presumptuous sins, knowing that they are wrong, will bring God’s CHASTENING and DISCIPLINE upon us, and that is never fun. Chastening is not the same as punishment, but is like a child getting a spanking in order **to TEACH the child NOT to do the bad behavior they were doing.**

Definition: “O Lord, my strength and my REDEEMER” – God is our Redeemer in that He **REDEEMS** us from our sin. **REDEMPTION**, the act of redeeming, **means buying back, freeing from captivity** by paying of a RANSOM. **Jesus PAID, with His blood**, for us to be **FREED** from the **CAPTIVITY of SIN.**
