Definition: "WRATH of GOD" - God's ANGER against SIN - the PUNISHMENT that WE DESERVE for violating God's laws and falling short of His perfect standards.

Definition: "RECONCILIATION" - To **restore** to friendship or harmony; to **BRING TOGETHER that which was separated**. God and man were in perfect harmony and

fellowship before Adam sinned, but SIN brought division, dissension, death and separation, so that now we MUST be **RECONCILED** to God.

Definition: "ENMITY" - Hostility, being and **ENEMY**. We were **ENEMIES** of God because we constantly failed to keep His **laws** and **commandments**.

Definition: "SAVED by His LIFE" - Now that we belong to God, we have SECURITY - He will keep us, guard us and deliver us by His power.

Definition: "a TYPE of Him who was to come" - Adam is used here as a CONTRAST to Jesus and what Jesus accomplished by His death and resurrection. Just as ADAM'S ACTIONS affected the WHOLE HUMAN RACE in a NEGATIVE way (bringing death), JESUS' ACTIONS affect the WHOLE HUMAN RACE in a POSITIVE WAY (to those who will BELIEVE, they bring LIFE).

Definition: "SIN was not IMPUTED" - "Imputed" means to hold something to someone's ACCOUNT. Where there was no specific list of commands (Before the time of Moses, when God gave the commandments - His Law) There was no strict ACCOUNTING of their points of violation. However, **DEATH REIGNED** over all mankind (everyone DIES ! !) - Adam's sin brought universal death! Also, even without the written Law of God, people still **know in their hearts** right from wrong, and still SIN AGAINST the HOLINESS of God.

Definition: "GRACE of GOD and GIFT of GRACE" - Grace means God's **FAVOR or love and acceptance** given to us WITHOUT our doing ANYTHING ! ! **We cannot earn it or pay for it or work for it!** ! **Grace** is God giving us GOOD THINGS we DON'T deserve, and **mercy** is God NOT GIVING us the **punishment we DO DESERVE**.
