

Romans 8:1-8

1. "There is therefore **NO CONDEMNATION** to those who are **IN CHRIST JESUS**, who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit."

- **Romans 3:33-34** "Who shall bring a _____ against God's elect (chosen ones)? It is God who _____. Who is he who _____? It is Christ who _____, and furthermore is also _____, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes _____ for us."

Definition: "NO CONDEMNATION" - To CONDEMN means to pronounce GUILTY, TO PRONOUNCE SENTENCE and JUDGE against, to DAMN. The Law brings CONDEMNATION, because we FAIL to keep God's law. The PENALTY TO KEEP the law is DEATH, and the ULTIMATE penalty is ETERNAL DEATH in HELL. **Jesus PAID the penalty FOR US, so we are NOT CONDEMNED or DAMNED to hell.**

- **I John 3:19-21** "And by this we _____ that we are of the _____ and shall _____ our hearts before Him. For if our heart _____ us, God is _____ than our heart, and knows all things. Beloved, if our _____ does not _____ us, we have _____ before God."

Definition: "If our HEART CONDEMNS US" - This word, "condemn," means "to find fault with," to blame. This is NOT talking about eternal condemnation, but about examining ourselves and CONFESSING OUR SINS to God. **See I John 1:9.** When we have confessed all of our sins to God, **we have CONFIDENCE** when we come before Him with our prayers.

- **Revelation 12:9:10** "So the great dragon was cast (thrown) out, that serpent of old, called the _____ and _____, who _____ the whole _____; he was cast to (thrown down to) the Earth, and his _____ were cast out with him. Then I heard a loud voice saying, 'Now _____, and strength, and the _____ of our God, and the _____ of His _____ have come, for the _____ of our brethren, who _____ them day and night, has been cast down.'"

Definition: "The ACCUSER of the Brethren" - This is another title for Satan, and "the Brethren" means "brothers," which is another name for Christians. Satan "ACCUSES us DAY and NIGHT," and this word, "accuse" means to "charge with some offense." IF YOU BELONG TO JESUS, and you feel you are under condemnation, Romans 8:1 says that the **condemnation is NOT coming from God.** The Holy Spirit brings CONVICTION of sin (He convinces us of the WRONG we are doing), but He does not CONDEMN us if we BELONG TO JESUS. If you have examined your own HEART, to see if there is any SIN YOU NEED TO CONFESS to the Lord, and you still feel condemnation even after confessing to God, the Satan is the source of that **condemnation or accusation.**

- **James 4:7** "Therefore _____ to God. _____ the _____, and he will flee (run away) from you." **RESIST Satan** by quoting scripture (God's word) OUT LOUD to him, especially Romans 8:1, and then BELIEVE GOD'S WORD, instead of Satan's accusations.

Definition: "WEAK through the FLESH" - "Flesh" in this context means primarily our HUMAN WILL. Our HUMAN WILLPOWER is too WEAK to keep us from sinning or to give us the POWER to OBEY GOD at all times. **We cannot live the Christian life (and in the Old Testament they could NOT KEEP GOD'S LAWS) by GOOD INTENTIONS and human WILLPOWER.**

Definition: "HIS OWN SON in the LIKENESS of sinful flesh" - Jesus was ALL GOD and ALL MAN, but He was COMPLETELY WITHOUT SIN in His humanity. If Jesus had NOT been completely SINLESS Himself, He could NOT have PAID for OUR SINS.

Definition: "the righteous REQUIREMENT of the LAW" - The law can't make a person holy, it can only DEMAND that we BE HOLY. Since our flesh (human nature) is so weak, and we cannot do the good we would like to do, we could never keep God's laws ourselves. However, God **IMPUTES to us** (applies to our account) the righteousness of Jesus Christ, and since He kept the law perfectly, the REQUIREMENT HAS BEEN FULFILLED through Jesus.

Definition: "CARNALLY MINDED" - to **THINK** like the **UNSAVED** people **think**, thinking only of material, fleshly things. The **OPPOSITE** of a person who is **CONTROLLED** by or " **FILLED WITH** " the Holy Spirit (spiritually minded).

Definition: "ENMITY" - Hostility, being an **enemy**. We are enemies of God because we constantly fail to keep His **laws** and **commandments**.

Definition: "CANNOT PLEASE GOD" and "DEAD WORKS" - These two are basically the same: **DEAD WORKS** are **religious works** or **good deeds** done in the **power of the flesh**, and a person who is **operating in their FLESH**, and not in **FAITH** and the **POWER** of the **HOLY SPIRIT**, **CANNOT DO ANYTHING** that will be **pleasing to God**.
