Definition: "BLASPHEME" - Blaspheme means to speak evil of; to speak irreverently or profanely, especially of God or sacred things; to curse or revile.

- **I Timothy 6:1** "Let as many servants as are under the yoke count their own masters worthy of all honor, so that the _____ of _____ and His doctrine may _____ be _____."

Definition: "MANY will FOLLOW their DESTRUCTIVE ways" - Who are we talking about here? Remember, chapter 2 verse one says, "**there will be FALSE TEACHERS among you, who will secretly bring in DESTRUCTIVE HERESIES.**" Peter is warning against these false teachers who will creep into Christian congregations and secretly teach things that are against the Bible. He says that **MANY will follow them, and that is why we have so many false cults in the world today**. Peter is not even talking about false religions such as Hinduism, Buddhism, Islam, and the like, but he is talking about **false groups that LOOK LIKE CHRISTIANS at first glance**, anyway, but they are not! Many gullible people are fooled by these false teachers, including many church members and even true Christians, but if they don't know the word of God well enough to discover the false teachings and "destructive ways" of these counterfeit religions, they will get sucked into a cult.

Definition: "GULLIBLE" - The dictionary defines gullible as "**easily CHEATED or TRICKED**; credulous". Credulous means "someone who **tends to believe too readily, especially with LITTLE or NO PROOF.**" We need to study and know God's word, so that we won't fall for the tricks of the false teachers! If we know what God's word says, we will not fall for their lies or be easily tricked.

- **Hebrews 5:13-14** "For everyone who partakes only of milk is _____ in the _____ of righteousness, for he is a babe. But solid food belongs to those who are of full age (mature), that is, those who by reason of _____ (practice, studying God's word) have their senses exercised to _____ both _____ and _____."

Definition: "And from such people TURN AWAY!" - God's word gives us instructions on how to GUARD ourselves from being deceived by false teachers. Jesus said, "**You will know them by their FRUITS**" (**Matt. 7:15-16**), so we have the right to judge someone's ministry or teaching to see if it is truly from God or not. **The Lord EXPECTS us to be DISCERNING**, and He certainly expects us to check everything out with His word (Hebrews 5:11-14, Acts 17:11). God expects us **to NOT be IGNORANT** of Satan's schemes and tricks! As for false prophets, false teaching, and false believers, we are told to "note and AVOID them" in Romans 16:17-18, and "**to TURN AWAY from such people!**" We are told to take HEED, BEWARE and WATCH in Acts 20:28-31 and Matthew 16:6 & 12, and **to CHECK everything out by the WORD** in Acts 17:11. "**Take heed**" means to **pay attention** or take notice. We must be AWARE of what others are teaching, but how can you know if it is right or wrong, if you don't know the word of God? You must **STUDY the word** and **SEARCH the word** to check out whether a certain teaching is from God or not.

- **II Timothy 2:15** "Be _____ to present yourself _____ to God, a worker who does _____ need to be ashamed, _____ dividing the _____ of truth."

Definition: "The Way of Truth will be blasphemed" - Because these false cults look enough like Christianity to fool some people, and because they use the Bible in their teachings (although they use it wrongly), true Christianity gets a bad rap. That's what it means by "**The Way of Truth will be blasphemed.**" These false teachers and their followers **CLAIM to be Christians, yet do not ACT like Christians, and so others judge the church by them, and say, "The church is full of hypocrites!"**

- **Matthew 7:15-17 & 22-23** "_____ of _____ prophets, who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous _____. You will know them by their _____. 3. By COVETOUSNESS they will EXPLOIT you with deceptive words; for a long time their JUDGMENT has NOT been IDLE, and their DESTRUCTION does not slumber.

Definition: "By COVETOUSNESS they will EXPLOIT you" - Covetousness means GREED or avarice; the wanting of something very badly. To EXPLOIT means "to make unethical use of for ones own advantage or profit." The false teachers covet and want desperately to have control of other people, power, prestige, and money that comes from devoted followers. In many cults, some of the followers even sell their houses and give up their bank accounts to the cult's leader.

- **I Timothy 6:3-5** "If anyone _____ otherwise and does _____ consent to _____ words, even the _____ of our Lord Jesus Christ, and to the doctrine which is according to godliness, he is _____, knowing nothing, but is _____ with disputes and _____ over words, from which come envy, strife, reviling, _____ suspicions, useless wranglings of men of _____ minds and destitute of the truth, who suppose the godliness is a means of gain (profit). Definition: "Their JUDGMENT has NOT been IDLE" - God has promised that He will judge and punish these false prophets, and He has not been idle in His judgment. Our method of keeping track of time is not the same as God's, and He will judge the evil in the world at the End of the Age, after Jesus returns to this earth to set up His kingdom. These false teachers, if they do not repent, will spend all of eternity in hell. We must just be patient and wait for God to judge them, and in the meantime, be alert and aware, and avoid them. We can also try to witness to some of their followers to get them out of the cults they are trapped in.

Definition: "God did not SPARE the ANGELS who SINNED" - Angels are called "sons of God" in Job 2:1, Job 38:7, and other Scriptures. If we believe the "sons of God" mentioned in Genesis 6:1-4 were angels, then they would be **disobedient angels**, who later are referred to as demons (those who rebelled with the archangel Lucifer, who became Satan). **Jude 6 speaks about "ANGELS who did NOT keep their own domain, but abandoned their proper abode,"** so this may refer to the unnatural act of angels mating with humans. We must assume that angels were able to take a physical form and procreate with humans (something which the Bible does not state), but **if that were possible, it would have produced a mixed, corrupted race**, which God then had to destroy. Perhaps Noah and his wife, his three sons and their wives were the only people left on the earth who did not have corrupted DNA, and therefore **God chose them to repopulate the earth**. Again, if that were possible, God must have punished those angels, and made it so this could not happen again, and **these "ANGELS who SINNED" are kept in chains for future judgment by God.** Many hold this theory, saying also that the Greek myths (the gods having children with humans, etc.) may have gotten their basis from these events, as the descendants of Noah would still have that memory to be passed down as folklore. The "men of old, men of renown" could mean **the heroes of mythology.**

- **Genesis 6:1-4** "Now it came about, when **men began to multiply** on the face of the land, and **daughters were born to them**, that the sons of God saw that the daughters of men were beautiful; and they took wives for themselves, whomever they chose. Then the Lord said, 'My Spirit shall not strive with man forever, because he also is flesh; nevertheless, his days shall be one hundred and twenty years. **The Nephilim (GIANTS) were on the earth in those days, and also afterward, when the sons of God came in to the daughters of men**, and they bore children to them. Those were the mighty men who were of old, men of renown."
- **I Peter 3:19-20** "By whom also He went and preached to the _____ in prison, who formerly were disobedient, when once the longsuffering of _____ waited in the _____ of _____, while the _____ was being _____, in which a few, that is, eight souls, were _____ through _____."

Definition: "He went and preached to the SPIRITS in prison" - Don't be confused and think that there is a chance to be saved after death. These "spirits in prison" who have been around since the time of Noah, are demon spirits, and not the spirits of human beings. Jesus went into the "Abyss" where these demons are **bound in CHAINS, awaiting the final JUDGMENT**, to show that He was triumphant over them and all of Satan's hordes. What did these demons do that was so bad that God has them chained up in the Abyss? According to Genesis 6:1-4, they were probably

fallen angels (demons) that had sexual relations with human women, creating a half-breed race of men who were exceedingly evil.
