Affirmations & Confessions of Faith Regarding Who God Says I Am in Christ

"Let us hold fast the confession of our faith without wavering,
for He who promised is faithful." Heb. 10:23

1. I confess that I am a Sheep of the Good Shepherd, Jesus Christ. I follow my Shepherd, and He takes care of me - John 10:1-16, 27-29; Psalm 23:1

1. I confess that I am Beloved of God. He loves me, and I am His beloved - III John 2; I John 4:1, 7,11 & 19

1. I confess that I am the Salt of the Earth. Salt purifies and preserves, and I help hold back the evil in the world by my witness for Christ, and by my holy lifestyle - Matthew 5:13

1. I confess that I am a Member of God's Royal Priesthood. As a priest, I can go directly to God in prayer - I Peter 2:9, Rev. 1:6, I Peter 2:5; Rev. 20:6; Heb. 4:16

1. I confess that I am a Saint, one of God's holy ones, because He has MADE me holy -
II Thess. 1:10, Romans 1:7; I Cor. 1:2

1. I confess that I am a Child of God, born into His family through faith in Jesus Christ, and God is now my Heavenly Father - Matt. 5:45 & 6:9; Jn. 11:52; I Jn. 3:10; Gal. 3:26; Jn 1:12

1. I confess that I am a Soldier of Jesus Christ, enlisted in the Army of God - Phil. 2:25,
II Timothy 2:3

1. I confess that I am Redeemed and Ransomed from my sins - Isaiah 51:11; Gal. 3:13-14

1. I confess that I am a Member of the Bride of Christ - Rev. 21:9; John 3:29; Rev. 22:17

1. I confess that I am a Member of the church & Body of Christ - I Corinthians 12:11-27; Ephesians 1:22-23

1. I confess that I am Just (Righteous), because I have been justified and made righteous by the blood of Jesus - Habakkuk 2:4; Romans 1:16-17; Rom. 5:9; II Cor. 5:21

1. I confess that I am an Heir of God and a Joint-Heir with Christ. My inheritance is listed in the "Last Will & Testament" of Jesus Christ - Romans 8:17; Gal. 4:7; Gal. 3:29

1. I confess that I am the Light of the world. I shine for Jesus Christ as I am a Witness for Him - Matt. 5:14-16; Acts 1:8, 5:32, 26:16

1. I confess that I am a Minister of the gospel of Jesus Christ, a Servant of Jesus Christ to others - Colossians 1:25; Romans 15:15-16

1. I confess that I am Elect, Chosen, Called, selected out from the world by God and for His eternal purpose - II John 1 & 13; I Peter 1:2, Romans 8:28-30

1. I confess that I am an Overcomer, and that I have faith to overcome all obstacles and difficulties in my way - I John 5:4-5

Affirmations & Confessions of Faith Regarding What Belongs to Me in Christ

1. I confess that I will have success, because "I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me" and because I am "Careful to do according to all that is written in God's word, for then I will make my way prosperous, and then I will have success" - Phil. 4:13; Joshua 1:8

1. I confess that my needs will always be met, because "My God shall supply all my needs according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus" and because I am "Seeking first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all the things I need will be added unto me" - Phil. 4:19; Matt. 6:33

1. I confess that I will not be afraid, because "God has not given me a spirit of fear, but of power, and love, and of a sound mind" and because "Whoever listens to Him will dwell safely, and will be secure, without fear of evil" and because "He is my refuge and my FORTRESS: my God, in Him will I trust" - II Timothy 1:7; Proverbs 1:33; Psalm 91:2

1. I confess that I have no need to worry, because I am "casting all my cares upon Him, for He cares for me" and I am "ANXIOUS for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, I let my REQUESTS be MADE KNOWN to GOD, and the PEACE of GOD, which surpasses all comprehension, guards my heart and mind in Christ Jesus" - I Peter 5:7; Phil. 4:6-7

1. I confess that I am free from condemnation, because "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus" - Romans 8:1

1. I confess that I am free to live life to the fullest, because "Where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty" and Jesus came to bring me "life, and that more abundantly" - II Cor. 3:17, John 10:10

1. I confess that I am able to overcome Satan in my life, because "Greater is He that is in me, than he that is in the world" - I John 4:4

1. I confess that I will have strength, and not be weak, because "The Lord is the strength of my life" and I will "wait on the Lord and shall renew my strength; I shall mount up with wings like an eagle; I shall run, and not be weary, and I shall walk, and not faint" - Psalm 27:1; Isaiah 40:31

1. I confess that I will have God's guidance in my life, because "He will INSTRUCT me and TEACH me in the way which I should go; He will GUIDE me with His eye" and I will "trust in the Lord with all my heart, and will not lean on my own understanding. In all my ways I will acknowledge Him, and He shall DIRECT my paths" - Psalm 32:8; Proverbs 3:5-6

1. I confess that I will have God's healing in my life, because I am "not be wise in my own eyes; but I fear (reverence) the Lord and depart from evil. It shall be health to my body and refreshment to my bones" and because I "bless the Lord, and do not forget His benefits: He forgives all my iniquities and heals all my diseases" and because Jesus "Himself took my infirmities and bore all my diseases" on the cross - Proverbs 3:7-8; Psalm 103:2-3; Matt. 8:17
