9. Having made known unto us the **mystery** of His will, according to **His good pleasure** which He has purposed in Himself.

- Definition: "mystery:" "something previously hidden or not known, that is now REVEALED by God."
- Read Ephesians 3:4-5 "..... you may understand my knowledge in the ______ of Christ, which in other ages was not made ______ by the Spirit to His holy apostles and prophets."
- Colossians 1:26-27 "..... the ______ which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been ______ to His saints."
- Luke 10:21 "... Jesus rejoiced in the Spirit and said, 'I praise You, Father, Lord of heaven and Earth, that You have ______ these things from the [worldly] wise and prudent and ______ them to babes. Even so, Father, for so it seemed ______ in Your sight."

10. That the dispensation of **the fullness of times** He might **gather together in one all things** in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on Earth -- in Him:

- **Galatians 4:4** "But when the ______ of time had come, God sent froth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law..."
- Mark 1:15 "And saying, 'The time is ______, and the kingdom of God is at hand (close by). Repent, and believe the gospel."
- Colossians 1:20 "..... by Him (Jesus) to reconcile ALL THINGS to Himself, by Him, whether things on _____ or things in _____, having made peace through the blood of His cross."
- Definition: "reconcile" "To restore to friendship or harmony; to BRING TOGETHER"

11. In whom also we have obtained an **inheritance**, being predestined according to the **purpose** of Him who **works all things** according to **the counsel of His own will**;

- Read Acts 26:13-18 (Verse 18) "... to open their eyes, and to turn them from darkness to light, and from the power of ______ to God, that they may receive ______ of sins, and an ______ among those who are sanctified by faith in Me."
- **Colossians 1:12-13** "Giving thanks to the Father, who has qualified us to be partakers of the ______ of the saints in light. He has delivered us from the power of and translated us into the kingdom or His dear Son."

12. That we should be to the praise of His glory, who first **trusted in Christ**.

- John 14:16-17 "And I will pray the Father, and He will give you another ______, that He may **abide with you forever**, even the Spirit of truth (Holy Spirit), whom the world cannot receive because it neither sees Him nor knows Him; but you know Him, for He dwells with you, and will be ______ ."

14. Which is the guarantee (pledge) of our inheritance until **the REDEMPTION of the PURCHASED possession**, unto the praise of His glory.

- Definition: "pledge" "a down-payment, a PROMISE that the full price will be paid" When we accept Christ as Saviour, our spirit is born again, and the Holy Spirit comes to live in us as a guarantee or promise until our BODY is redeemed and made perfect at the RESURRECTION.
- Romans 8:9-11 & 21-23 (Verse 11) "But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead wells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give ______ to your mortal ______ through His ______ who dwells in you." (Verse 23) "...but we also who have the first fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption, the ______ of our ______."
- I Peter 1:18-19 "Knowing that your were not redeemed (PURCHASED) with corruptible things, such as ______ and _____ from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers (ancestors), but with the precious blood of _____, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot."
- I Thessalonians 5:23 "Now may the God of peace Himself sanctify you completely; and may to your whole ______, soul, and ______ be preserved blameless at the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ."
