	understanding would be enlightened; that I may know what is the hope of YOUR
	calling for ME, and what are the riches of the glory of MY inheritance in the saints;
	and what is the exceeding greatness of YOUR power toward ME, because I believe,
	according to the working of YOUR mighty power. Thank you, Lord.
	What does "the hope of His calling " mean? It means that God has a plan for your
	life, but that plan is based entirely on His calling and choosing you by His
	grace, not based on any works of goodness or intelligence of your own!! (See
	Ephesians 2:8-10, Titus 3:3-7)
•	Read II Timothy 1:8-9 (Verse 9) "Who has saved us and us with a
	holy CALLING , not according to, but according to His own purpose and grace which was GIVEN to us in Christ Jesus before time began."
	own purpose and grace which was GIVEN to us in Christ Jesus before time began."

•	Read Romans 8:28-31 "For whom He foreknew , him He also PREDESTINATED to be conformed to the image of , that He (Jesus) might be the firstborn among many brethren. Moreover, whom He predestined, these He also, whom HE called , these He also, and whom He justified, these He also"	
•	I Corinthians 1:26-29 "For you see your, brethren, that not many are CALLED . But God has chosen the things of the world to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the things of the world to put to the things which are mighty; and the base things of the world, and the things which are God has, (Verse 29) That no flesh (no human being) should glory in His"
