Definition: "Circumcision" - refers to the Jews - circumcision was the "sign" of their covenant with God

covenant with God. Definition: "Gentiles" or "Uncircumcision" - in this context means non-Jews. Read Colossians 2:11-13 "In Him you were also circumcised with the circumcision made _____, by putting off the body of the sins of the flesh, by the circumcision of ______, buried with Him in baptism, in which you also were with Him through faith in the working of God, who raised Him from the dead. And you being _____ in your trespasses (sins) and the uncircumcision of your flesh, He has made alive together with Him, having forgiven you all trespasses (sins)." 12. And at that time, you [Gentiles] were without Christ, being aliens from the commonwealth (blessings) of Israel, and strangers from the covenants of promise, having no hope, and without God in this world. **Definition:** "Covenant" - "an agreement or promise, a contract between two parties" • Isaiah 56:4-7 "For thus says the Lord, 'To [those] who keep My sabbaths, and choose what pleases Me, and TAKE HOLD OF MY COVENANT, I will give them an everlasting name which will not be cut off.
