Definition: "ACCESS" - "permission, liberty or ability to enter, approach, communicate with" - through Jesus, we can enter God's throne room, approach Him and communicate with Him in prayer.

- **Romans 5:1-2** "Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ: by whom also we have by FAITH in this wherein we stand."
- John 10:1, 7 & 9 "Most assuredly I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the DOOR, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber." (Verse 7) "Then said to them, 'Most assuredly I say to you, **I AM THE** DOOR of the sheep.' (Verse 9) "I am the ______. Note: Notice how the Holy Spirit is called both the "Spirit of God" and the "Spirit of Christ" -- this is just one of many scriptures that proves that the Bible teaches ONE **GOD**, yet He exists in **THREE PERSONS**, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit (the Trinity). Also, Ephesians 2:18 in itself mentions the three persons of the Godhead: THROUGH Him (Christ the SON) we have access TO the FATHER, BY the SPIRIT.

Definition: "STONE OF STUMBLING" ____ Putting your **trust in Jesus** to save you and **believing that what He did** on the cross PAID FOR YOUR SINS is so simple that many people "**stumble over it**" or cannot accept it. They want to be able to DO SOMETHING to EARN their own salvation, and they refuse to accept GOD'S WAY of salvation. Some people reject Jesus altogether, but many want to INCLUDE Jesus in **their own system** of work, good deeds and religious ideas. By doing this they are **DISOBEDIENT to God's word**, because God's word says salvation is by **FAITH IN JESUS plus NOTHING ELSE ! !**
