Definition: "VANITY OF THEIR MINDS" - means emptiness and stupidity of their minds; **not thinking right**, not able to understand the things of God."

Definition: "No longer WALK as the rest of the Gentiles" - Paul is speaking to born-again Christians here, the church at Ephesus, and telling them NOT to CONTINUE TO LIVE THEIR LIVES or BEHAVE like **non-Christians**. He especially tells them **NOT** to **THINK like unbelievers**.

Definition: "WHO BEING PAST FEELING" - Without listening to their conscience; having no remorse; not being sorry for doing wrong.

Definition: "LICENTIOUSNESS" - means "lacking of deficient in discipline; without restraint, LAWLESSNESS; doing whatever feels good at the time." Do we see much of this in our society today? _____

Lawlessness will be one of the "signs" of His soon return, and the condition of the human race **just before Jesus returns** will be as wicked and evil as it was before God destroyed the Earth with the Flood. Read also II Thessalonians 2:1-12 & II Timothy 3:1-13.

Definition: "SOWING and REAPING" - Sowing means planting seeds, and reaping means harvesting or gathering the crop that has grown from those seeds. For Christians, this means that we may still have to suffer the CONSEQUENCES of our sinful behavior, even though God has FORGIVEN us.

God **CREATES the new nature (the "NEW MAN") in us when we are **BORN AGAIN** (our **spirits are MADE ALIVE**), when we receive Jesus as our Savior, but there is a daily conscious decision we must make to LET the NEW Nature and God's Spirit CONTROL US. **We must yield or surrender our bodies to God** every day, even moment by moment, and **give Him the right** to use us as His servants.

Definition: "**RENEWED** and "**TRANSFORMED**" - If we want to see positive changes in our lives, we **must renew our minds** by constantly reading the **word of God**. Otherwise, we will think, act and talk just like the rest of the **world**. As our**minds** are changed (our way of thinking), we will begin to see things as God sees them, and our outward behavior will change. We will "Walk in the Spirit and will not fulfill (carry out) the lusts of the flesh (the Old Man)." Galatians 5:16
