	Definition: " Commandment with a promise" - Keeping God's commandments
	does not EARN us our salvation (salvation is by faith in Jesus Christ ONLY), but
	obedience AFFECTS the QUALITY of our lives here on EARTH, and the LENGTH of our
	lives.
	Definition: "Obey in the Lord" - This means to OBEY our human parents as long as
	they are NOT asking us to do something that is AGAINST a COMMAND of the Lord. The
	same thing is meant by Eph. 5:21-22 "SUBMITTING to one another in fear of God .
	Wives, SUBMIT to your own husbands, AS TO THE LORD . We are not to SUBMIT or
	OBEY church leader, or a wife is not to obey her husband, if they ask us to do
	something that is AGAINST A WRITTEN COMMAND of God in the Bible.

	Definition: "PROVOKE your children TO WRATH" - Children need LOVING.

Definition: "PROVOKE your children TO WRATH" - Children need LOVING, CONSISTENT discipline, correction and TRAINING from their parents. If they don't get it; if the get NO DISCIPLINE, or INCONSISTENT discipline (the LAZY PARENT), or are "disciplined" in ANGER (the parents **taking out their FRUSTRATIONS** on the child in ANGER or even VIOLENCE), the children will grow up ANGRY THEMSELVES, thinking repeatedly, "NOTHING I ever do is right," "I can NEVER PLEASE my parents," "I'm a LOSER," etc. This is very DESTRUCTIVE, not only to the child, but to THEIR children, and on down for many generations (see Exodus 20:5).

Definition: "ADMONITION" - GENTLE reproof, counsel or WARNING of consequences of disobedience; ENCOURAGEMENT and advice, especially in indicating duties and obligations.

5-6. SERVANTS, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh , with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart , as to Christ; not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as servants of Christ , doing the will of God from the heart.

Definition: "Eyeservice, as men-pleasers" - Doing what is right, or working hard ONLY when someone is WATCHING.		
• Read Matthew 6:1-6 (Verse 5) "And when you pray, you shall not be like the hypocrites. For they love to pray standing in the synagogues and on the corners of the streets, that they may be by Assuredly, I say to you, they have their reward [this is their ONLY reward]."		
Definition: "Masters according to the flesh" - Your Earthly "master," or EMPLOYER. These scriptural principles APPLY TO US today in our EMPLOYEE/EMPLOYER relationships.		
7. With good will doing SERVICE, as to the Lord, and not to men.

Definition: "MOCK" - To treat with CONTEMPT, insult; to DEFY or CHALLENGE.		
Definition: "SOWING and REAPING" - Sowing means planting seed, and reaping means harvesting or gathering the crop that has grown from those seeds. For Christians, this means that we may still have to suffer the CONSEQUENCES of our sinful behavior ("seeds" we have "planted"), even though God has FORGIVEN us. Sowing and reaping is mostly referring to our time HERE ON EARTH, although it may mean a LACK of REWARDS in heaven, as well.

	Definition: "SAVED AS BY FIRE" - This refers to people who have received Jesus as
	Savior, been born again, and are SAVED, but who have never really made Jesus LORD OF ALL in their life. This person may make it to heaven, but will receive NO
	REWARDS!! All of their so-called good works were done in their own human strength (in the FLESH), and are WORTHLESS (Jesus said, "Without Me, you can do
	NOTHING." John 15:5) - The worthless, human "works" will be burned up. The picture here is similar to a person escaping from a burning house, and they make it out alive,
	but ALL THEIR POSSESSIONS are burned up, and they have NOTHING! This also
	applies to "death bed" conversions, such as the thief on the cross (Luke 23:39-43), where the person has \bf{no} time to do any GOOD WORKS.
