as a FREE GIFT from God, and NOT by the WORKS of the law. However, "works" in the context of James 2:14-26 means EVIDENCE that your faith in Christ is REAL. TRUE FAITH will always have corresponding action. In James 2:14-26, there is a warning to beware of those who are just "full of hot air" and show no real change in their lives or have anything to show for their supposed faith in Christ. A person who has asked God to take control of their life and Jesus to come into their heart SHOULD start acting like Jesus, even if only in small ways at first. A new Believer, of course, wouldn't have as many "works" as someone who has been saved a long time, but they should have some EVIDENCE
