Yes, the Pharisees and Jewish leaders were PHYSICAL descendants of Abraham, but as far as God is concerned, the important thing is to be a SPIRITUAL descendant of Abraham. Abraham is called the "Father of Faith," so if we have put our faith in Christ, we are Abraham's descendants (children).
