

# “Love Lifted Me Recovery Ministries”

## Hebrews Bible Study — Hebrews 4:13-16 & 5:1-3      Lesson #9

\*\*INSTRUCTIONS: Read the entire section of Scripture in Hebrews before starting to look up the other Scripture verses and filling in the blanks. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding as you read God’s word. Most Scriptures used are from the New King James Version.

13 And there is **NO creature HIDDEN from His SIGHT**, but all things are naked and open to the eyes of Him to whom we must give account.

• **Ephesians 5:13** “But all things that are \_\_\_\_\_ are made \_\_\_\_\_ by the \_\_\_\_\_, for whatever makes manifest is light.”

• **Psalms 90:8** “You have set our iniquities (sins) before You, our \_\_\_\_\_ in the \_\_\_\_\_ of Your countenance (face).”

**Definition: “MANIFEST”** — Evident, shown, displayed, easily seen.

**Definition: “NO creature HIDDEN from His SIGHT”** – According to the Scripture verses in Ezekiel 8:1-18, we see that it is NOT possible to hide our sinful actions from God. The Israelites thought they could HIDE their idolatrous practices from God, but **the Spirit of God took Ezekiel into their innermost secret chambers and SHOWED him EVERYTHING that they were doing.** We cannot hide our sinful actions from God. Psalm 139:11-12 says, “The DARKNESS shall NOT HIDE from YOU”. This means that **God can see in the darkness, and nothing can be hidden from Him.**

Where it says, “If I say, ‘Surely the darkness shall fall on me,’ it is a person thinking that they can hide something from God, for instance, if they do it in the darkness. People who do evil things like to do them in darkness, and that might hide it from some people, but **nothing can hide their evil deeds from God.**”

• **John 3:19-21** “And this is the \_\_\_\_\_, that the \_\_\_\_\_ has come into the world, and men loved \_\_\_\_\_ rather than \_\_\_\_\_, because their deeds were \_\_\_\_\_.”

14-15 Seeing then that **we have a great HIGH PRIEST who has passed through the heavens**, Jesus the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession. For we do **not have a high priest who cannot sympathize with our weaknesses**, but was in all points tempted as we are, yet without sin.

• **Hebrews 7:20-28** “And inasmuch as He was not made \_\_\_\_\_ without an oath (for they have become priests without an oath, but He with an oath by Him who said to Him: ‘the Lord has sworn and will not relent, You are a \_\_\_\_\_ forever according to the order of Melchizedek’), by so much more \_\_\_\_\_ has become a surety of a better covenant. And there were many \_\_\_\_\_, because they were prevented by \_\_\_\_\_ from continuing. But He (Jesus), because He continues \_\_\_\_\_, has an unchangeable \_\_\_\_\_.  
Therefore He is also able to \_\_\_\_\_ to the \_\_\_\_\_ those who come to \_\_\_\_\_ through Him, since He ever \_\_\_\_\_ to make intercession for them. **Definition: “A great HIGH PRIEST who has passed through the heavens”** – Jesus “passing through the heavens” has two meanings: (1) Micah 5:2 prophesied that Bethlehem would be the birthplace of the Messiah, the future ruler of Israel, and that **this One (Jesus) has existed from ALL ETERNITY or “from EVERLASTING” which means in HEAVEN**; (2) **Jesus ascended into heaven** after He arose from the dead, as First Timothy 3:16 says He was “received up in GLORY.”

• **1 Timothy 3:16** “And without controversy great is the \_\_\_\_\_ of godliness: \_\_\_\_\_ was manifested (revealed) in the \_\_\_\_\_, justified in the Spirit, seen by angels, preached among the Gentiles, \_\_\_\_\_ on in the world, received up in \_\_\_\_\_.”

• **Micah 5:2** “But you, Bethlehem [*in*] Ephrathah, though you are little among the thousands of Judah, yet \_\_\_\_\_ of you shall come forth to Me the One to be \_\_\_\_\_ in Israel, whose \_\_\_\_\_ forth have been from of old, from \_\_\_\_\_.”

• **Luke 24:51** “Now it came to pass, while He blessed them, that \_\_\_\_\_ was parted from them and \_\_\_\_\_ up into \_\_\_\_\_.”

**Definition: “He might be a merciful and FAITHFUL HIGH PRIEST”** – A priest in the Old Testament was the only one allowed into the inner part of the temple to offer sacrifices to God. Jesus paid for our sins with His own death on the cross, and **He presented His blood on the altar in heaven**, before God the Father as the **“PROPITIATION for our SINS.”** Now, **Jesus has made US to be priests** ourselves, and we do NOT need any kind of human priest to come to God for us, as **Jesus is our High Priest** and we are qualified to come before God ourselves because of Jesus.

• **Revelation 5:9-12** “And they sang a new song, saying, ‘You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; for \_\_\_\_\_ were \_\_\_\_\_, and have redeemed us to \_\_\_\_\_ by Your \_\_\_\_\_ out of every tribe and tongue (language) and people and nation, and have made \_\_\_\_\_ kings and \_\_\_\_\_ to our God; and \_\_\_\_\_ shall reign on the earth.’

• **Hebrews 2:17** “Therefore, in all things He \_\_\_\_\_ to be \_\_\_\_\_ like His \_\_\_\_\_, that He might be a \_\_\_\_\_ and faithful \_\_\_\_\_ in things pertaining to \_\_\_\_\_, to make \_\_\_\_\_ for the \_\_\_\_\_ of the \_\_\_\_\_.”

**Definition:** “Definition: “PROPITIATION for the SINS of the PEOPLE” – PROPITIATION means something that gains the favor or goodwill of someone else. **The sacrifice of Jesus on the cross GAINED GOD’S GOOD WILL and FAVOR for us, so that we can enter into RELATIONSHIP with Him.**

• **Romans 3:24-25a** “Being \_\_\_\_\_ freely by His \_\_\_\_\_ through the \_\_\_\_\_ that is in Christ Jesus, whom God set forth to be a \_\_\_\_\_ by His \_\_\_\_\_, through faith.....”

• **I John 1:7** “But if we walk in the light, as He is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_ His Son \_\_\_\_\_ from all \_\_\_\_\_.”

16 Let us therefore **come BOLDLY to the THRONE of GRACE**, that we may **obtain MERCY and find GRACE to HELP in time of NEED.**

• **Isaiah 16:5** “In \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ will be established; and One (Jesus) will \_\_\_\_\_ on it in \_\_\_\_\_, in the tabernacle of David, judging and seeking justice and hastening \_\_\_\_\_.”

• **Acts 26:22** “Therefore, having \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_,

to this day I stand, witnessing both to small and great, saying no other things than those which the prophets and Moses said would come.”

• **Exodus 33:18-19** “Then he [Moses] said, ‘Please, show me Your \_\_\_\_\_. • **Exodus 34:5-6** “Then the \_\_\_\_\_ descended in the cloud, and stood with him there, and proclaimed the name of the Lord. • **I Chronicles 16:34** “O give thanks unto the \_\_\_\_\_, for He is \_\_\_\_\_; for His \_\_\_\_\_ endures forever.”

**Definition:** “Come BOLDLY to the THRONE of GRACE” – Through FAITH in Jesus, because we have been cleansed from our sins by His BLOOD, we can **enter God’s throne room, approach Him and communicate** with Him in **prayer**. When we KNOW that we can approach God the Father to ask Him for help, we “**Obtain MERCY and find GRACE to HELP in time of NEED**”

• **Hebrews 10:19** “Therefore, brethren, having \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ the \_\_\_\_\_ by the \_\_\_\_\_ of \_\_\_\_\_.”

• **Ephesians 2:18** ““For through \_\_\_\_\_ we both have \_\_\_\_\_ by one Spirit to the \_\_\_\_\_.”

• **Psalms 103:2-4** “Bless the \_\_\_\_\_, O my soul; and \_\_\_\_\_ not all His \_\_\_\_\_.”

**Definition: "ACCESS" – Access means "permission, liberty or ability to enter, approach, communicate with" someone, and in this case, it is the ability to approach God in prayer.**

• **Romans 5:1-2** "Therefore, being justified by faith, we have peace with God \_\_\_\_\_ our Lord \_\_\_\_\_ : by whom also we have \_\_\_\_\_ by \_\_\_\_\_ into this \_\_\_\_\_ wherein we stand."

## Chapter 5

1-3 For **every HIGH PRIEST taken from among MEN** is appointed for men in things pertaining to God, that he may offer both gifts and sacrifices for sins. He can have compassion on those who are ignorant and going astray, **since he himself is also beset by weakness**. Because of this he is required as for the people, so also for himself, to offer for sins.

• **Leviticus 9:7** "And Moses said to \_\_\_\_\_, 'Go to the altar, \_\_\_\_\_ your \_\_\_\_\_ and your burnt \_\_\_\_\_, and make \_\_\_\_\_ for \_\_\_\_\_ and for the \_\_\_\_\_. Offer the \_\_\_\_\_ of the people, and make \_\_\_\_\_ for them, as the Lord commanded.'"

**Definition: "Every HIGH PRIEST taken from among MEN" – The Old Testament priests were MEN who needed forgiveness for their OWN SINS, as well as offering sacrifices for the sins of the people of Israel. They were also LIMITED in their time of serving because of old age, WEAKNESS and DEATH. These human priests were only SYMBOLIC of the TRUE high priest who would come, JESUS, the Messiah. Jesus is without sin and no longer subject to death (after His death and resurrection). We, as believers in Christ, are under the NEW COVENANT; JESUS is our HIGH PRIEST, which means we COME to GOD THROUGH HIM, but we do NOT need a human priest of any kind. Jesus is our ADVOCATE, which means DEFENSE LAWYER. JESUS defends us against the ACCUSATIONS of Satan. Jesus is DEFENDING and PROTECTING US by His intercessory PRAYER for us, and as our MEDIATOR, He has opened the way for us to come directly into God's presence.**

• **Hebrews 4:14** "Seeing then that we have a great \_\_\_\_\_ who has passed through the heavens, \_\_\_\_\_ the Son of God, let us hold fast our confession."

• **Hebrews 7:25-26** "Therefore He (Jesus) is also able to \_\_\_\_\_ to the uttermost (completely) those who \_\_\_\_\_ to \_\_\_\_\_ through \_\_\_\_\_, since He ever (always) lives to make \_\_\_\_\_ for them. For such a High \_\_\_\_\_ was fitting for us, who is \_\_\_\_\_, harmless (sinless), undefiled, \_\_\_\_\_ from \_\_\_\_\_, and has become higher than the heavens."

• **Isaiah 59:16** "He saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no \_\_\_\_\_; therefore His own arm (strength) brought \_\_\_\_\_ for Him, and His own \_\_\_\_\_, it sustained Him."
