No one else can become a son of God in the same sense as Jesus (JESUS IS GOD in the FLESH), but we can become sons and daughters of God, and be born into His family BY FAITH in Jesus Christ (John 1:12).

Definition: "SHOULD NOT PERISH" - "Perish" in the Bible means to be thrown into hell forever - everlasting DESTRUCTION. It does NOT mean to just not exist anymore. Some religions and cults teach that a person just goes into oblivion after death, that there is no more consciousness (sometimes called "soul sleep"). The Bible teaches that there is ETERNAL PUNISHMENT for those who reject God's way of salvation.

Trying to keep the commandments only brings CONDEMNATION, because we FAIL to keep God's law --NO ONE EVER keeps (obeys) ALL the commandments ALL of the time. The penalty for FAILURE TO KEEP the law is DEATH, and the ULTIMATE penalty is ETERNAL DEATH in HELL. Jesus PAID the penalty FOR US, so we are NOT CONDEMNED or DAMNED to hell if we BELIEVE and PUT our COMPLETE TRUST in Him.

Definition: "CONDEMNED ALREADY" - The question we should ask is not, "Why does God send anybody to hell?" but rather, "Why does God SAVE ANYBODY at all?" **EVERYONE ON THIS EARTH is ALREADY on their way to HELL!** God, in His great love and mercy, has **provided a WAY OF ESCAPE** through believing on **His Son Jesus Christ!** If anyone rejects or ignores **God's ONLY WAY of ESCAPE from hell**, it is their OWN FAULT that they end up in hell for all eternity - God did not SEND them there.
