	Definition: "ALL WHO are in the GRAVES" - This is different than John 5:25 which
	says "the DEAD will hear His voice." Verse 25 is speaking of those who are ALIVE
	PHYSICALLY, but are SPIRITUALLY DEAD. Now, He is talking about those who are
	PHYSICALLY DEAD and their bodies are in the grave. The Bible sometimes refers to
	death as being "asleep," but it is NEVER a SOUL SLEEP. Only the physical BODY is
	"asleep" and waiting to be AWAKENED at the resurrection. The SOULS of the people
	have already gone on either to be with God, if they were saved, or for the UNSAVED,
	to await the JUDGMENT and be thrown into hell.

Definition: "The RESURRECTION of CONDEMNATION" - This will take place immediately after the thousand years are over (Rev. 20:5) and is **for unbelievers only**. They will then be judged on the basis of their works and their **works will NOT be enough to save them**. Because they have REJECTED CHRIST and His atonement, they must bear their own punishment for their sins, and will be thrown into the lake of fire (also called "The Second Death" - see Rev. 20:12-14, 21:8). The Antichrist and his false prophet are the first ones to be thrown in the Lake of Fire, and they are the only ones thrown into it BEFORE the Millennium (see Rev. 19:20). Interesting note: **they are still there AFTER the 1,000 years** are finished. They are NOT consumed in the fire, but are still conscious!
