These names or titles for Jesus correspond with the names of God in the Old Testament. When Moses asked God in the burning bush to give him a name to tell the people, God simply said, "I AM THAT I AM" (Exodus 3:13-14). In other places in the Bible, God would say "I AM" and then add to His name whatever it was you needed. For example, "I AM the God who heals you" (Exodus 15:26) or "I AM the Provider" (Genesis 22:14). Jesus does the SAME THING. He says "I AM" and adds to it whatever we need in a spiritual sense: "I AM the Bread of Life," "I AM the Door," "I AM the Resurrection and the Life," "I AM the Light of the World," "I AM the Vine."
