Then they took up stones to throw at Him; but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple, going through the midst of them, and so passed by. **Exodus 3:14** "And said to Moses, "I WHO I AM; and He said, Thus you shall say to the sons of Israel, 'I _____ has sent me to you.'" Definition: "BEFORE Abraham was, I AM" - "I AM" was the name of God given to those under the Old Covenant (Old Testament). It simply means He has no beginning or end, but has ALWAYS EXISTED. When God appeared to Moses in the burning bush (Exodus 3:14) He said, "Tell them 'I AM' has sent you." When the Jews heard Jesus use this term for Himself, THEY KNEW EXACTLY WHAT HE MEANT BY IT, and they picked up stones to stone Him to death, because He was saying He was God! In trying to translate into English, this name is sometimes referred to as "Jehovah" or "Yahweh." We don't really know how it was pronounced by the Hebrews, because they thought God's name was too holy to speak or write, but IT IS NOT NECESSARY for us to know it. The NAME that is GIVEN TO US is the NAME OF JESUS (see Acts 4:12), and Jesus revealed God to us in the New Covenant (New Testament) as "the Father".
