	<b>Definition:</b> "It is NOT LAWFUL" - God's law that He gave to Israel through Moses said that NO WORK was to be done on the Sabbath Day. In Jesus' day, the Pharisees had ADDED many rules and regulations to God's original law, including definitions of what constituted "work" and how many steps you could walk on the Sabbath, etc. Instead of being a day to rest and refresh yourself, they had made it a day of horrible rules to keep, and people were afraid of "breaking the Sabbath rules" (see Matthew 23:1-4). The Sabbath Day and the penalty of death were given to the "sons of Israel." We, as Christians under the New Covenant, are <b>NOT under the Sabbath Law</b> with its penalty, but the PRINCIPLE of taking a day to rest and be refreshed, and to set that day apart for the Lord, is still applicable.
