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Definition: "Whoever wants to be a FRIEND of the WORLD" - Being a "friend of the world" or loving the things of this world more than how much we love Jesus is a problem with a lot of us. God's word says it is a very serious problem, though, and actually **makes us enemies of God** when we love the world more than we love Him.

In Mark 10:17-23, we see the "Rich Young Ruler" (see also Luke 18:18-25) who has "kept all the commandments from his youth" but who **LOVES his money and possessions more than he LOVES Jesus.**

	Definition: "No one is GOOD but One, that is GOD" - Jesus "tested" the rich young ruler in two areas. The first area was in whether the young man believed Jesus was just a "good man" or the Son of God, actually God in the flesh. In order for a person to be saved, they must believe in Jesus as the Savior and Son of God, not just a "good man" or a prophet. Jesus is God in human form, in the flesh, so He is good, but He is pointing out to this man that if he's going to call Him "good" he must believe also that Jesus is indeed God.

	Definition: "Jesus, looking at him, LOVED him, and said, 'One thing you LACK" - Some people get mixed up and confused, and think that Jesus is teaching that we must ALL give up our wealth and possessions and give it to the poor, in order to please God. That is not what Jesus is teaching here, but He is "testing" the rich young man to see whether he loves his money and material possessions more than God. It is actually a test to see if the young man has kept the first commandment, which is to "have no other gods before" the one true God. This young man boasted that he had kept all the other commandments, but in this one, the most important, he failed. Obviously, the rich young man had made his money and possessions his "god", because he was sad, and went away, and did not follow Jesus.
