| Definition: "SHARED with ME concerning GIVING and RECEIVING" - The so-called "prosperity |
| preachers" have gone overboard, and because of them, some Christians have not understood what God's |
| word really says about RECEIVING financial and material blessings from God. If we follow the law of |
| sowing and reaping, we see that the person who holds onto "their money" tightly, and is stingy in their |
| giving to the Lord (sows sparingly), will also reap fewer and smaller blessings from the Lord. The person |
| who is generous and cheerful in their giving will receive (reap) greater blessings from God, and all of their |
| needs will be taken care of by God. To the one who is faithful in tithing and giving offerings, the Lord |
| even promises to "open the windows of heaven and pour out blessings" that will be over and above what |
| we need. Jesus promises that "with the SAME MEASURE that you use, it shall be measured to you |
| again." This is the law of sowing and reaping, just using different words. |
