**Definition:** "Strong BULLS of Bashan have encircled Me. They GAPE at Me with their mouths, as a raging and roaring LION" – This is just a very descriptive way of saying there are enemies all around me. It is David speaking about his own enemies, and again, he is also prophesying of Jesus, when He was surrounded by His enemies at the crucifixion.

Definition: "They shall look on Him whom they PIERCED" - The word "pierced" refers to the nailing of Jesus to the cross. This is the most hideous part of the crucifixion. The victim was placed or his back with arms outstretched, and was mounted on the cross before it was placed in its upright position. To hold the person in place, the soldiers drove large iron spikes into the feet and wrists. It is reassuring to know that when we suffer, we are understood by a Savior who Himself suffered deeply and severely. For this term to be used in the prophecy of the Messiah's death a thousand years before it happened (Psalm 22:16-17), was amazing, because the common form of capital punishment for the Jews at that time was stoning to death. Crucifixion had not even been invented when David wrote abou it in the Psalms. Later, in Zechariah, it says that the Jews will see their Messiah when He comes again in the clouds, and they will see that He is the One they rejected and who was pierced, because they will see the nail prints in His hands.  *Zechariah 13:6
