## QUESTION: What are the differences between heaven and the 1,000 year kingdom?

## ANSWER:

## Millennium (1,000 Year Kingdom)

- 1. The Millenium will be for a **limited time** of 1,000 years; it is a **temporary** kingdom. (Rev. 20:4, 6-7)
- 2. There will be **unsaved people** in the kingdom. (Zechariah 14:16, Isaiah 65:18-25, Rev. 20:7-10), but some will be saved during that time. (Zech. 8:2-23)
- 3. The **earth will still be under the curse**, but Jesus will be imposing His reign over it, and subduing it. (Rev. 20:1-6, Rev. 2:26-27, Isa. 65:25, Isa. 11:1-9)
- 4. **Satan will be allowed** to come and deceive the nations one last time, and then he will be destroyed forever. (Rev. 20:7-10)
- 5. The Millennium will be **BEFORE the Great White Throne Judgment**. (Rev. 20:11-15)
- 6. **Still operating under time**: days, months, years. (Zechariah 14:8-9,16-17)
- 7. Many will still have **mortal bodies**, and will be having children. (Isa. 65:20-23)

## Heaven (Eternal Kingdom)

- 1. Heaven is **ETERNAL** It is a PERMANENT kingdom, and **it has no end**. (Daniel 7:13-14, Rev. 22:5, I Thess. 4:16-17)
- 2. **Only those who belong to Jesus** and are written in the Lamb's Book of Life will be in the heavenly kingdom. (Rev. 21:27, Heb. 12:22-23, Phil. 4:3, John 14:1-6, Matt. 7:21-23, Rev. 20:15)
- 3. There will be a **new heavens and a new earth**, and no more curse. (Rev. 22:3, Rev. 21:1-5)
- 4. There will be **no more threat of Satan**, no more tears, disease, pain, death, etc. (Rev. 20:10, Rev. 21:4, Isa. 35:9-10, Isa. 25:8-9, Isa. 65:19, Isa. 51:11)
- 5. The heavenly kingdom will continue for all eternity **AFTER the Final Judgment**. (Rev. 20:11-15 & 21:1-5)
- 6. **No more measuring of time** in ETERNITY. (Rev. 22:5)
- 7. Everyone will have their perfect, **resurrection body**. (Romans 8:21-23, I Cor. 15:42-54, Rev. 21:4-5)
