It is **NOT a process** of becoming righteous, it is a ONE-TIME ACT of GRACE- we are MADE RIGHTEOUS the moment we accept Jesus as our Savior! It is NOT merely FORGIVENESS, although forgiveness is INCLUDED - God does indeed FORGIVE AND FORGET OUR SINS. However, JUSTIFICATION means God even FORGETS THAT WE WERE EVER SINNERS! There is NO MORE RECORD of our sins.

Definition: "ACCESS" - "permission, liberty or ability to enter, approach, communicate with." Through Jesus, we can enter God's throne room, approach Him and communicate with Him in prayer."
