Definition: "SIN was not IMPUTED" - "Imputed" means to hold something to someone's ACCOUNT. Where there was no specific list of commands (Before the time of Moses, when God gave the commandments - His Law) There was no strict ACCOUNTING of their points of violation. However, DEATH REIGNED over all mankind (everyone DIES!!) - Adam's sin brought universal death! Also, even without the written Law of God, people still know in their hearts right from wrong, and still SIN AGAINST the HOLINESS of God.
