It is NOT a process ofbecoming righteous, it is a ONE-TIME ACT of GRACE - we are MADE RIGHTEOUS the moment we accept Jesus as our Savior! It is NOT merely FORGIVENESS, although forgiveness is INCLUDED - God does indeed FORGIVE AND FORGET OUR SINS. However, JUSTIFICATION means God even FORGETS THAT WE WERE EVER SINNERS! There is NO MORE RECORD or our sins.

Definition: "The GIFT of RIGHTEOUSNESS" - God MAKES us righteous when we BELIEVE in Jesus Christ and RECEIVE HIM as our Lord and Savior. That RIGHTEOUSNESS is a GIFT, not something we can EARN. As in Romans 9:31-33 and 10:1-4, the Jews, and many other people REFUSE TO ACCEPT salvation as a FREE GIFT from God. They continue to TRY TO EARN salvation and "seek to establish their own righteousness," and thus miss out on God's righteousness altogether. 	ALREADY IS EQUAL with God. Then, in verse 7, it says He "made Himself of no
	reputation," which could also be said as "HE EMPTIED HIMSELF of His powers as God."
	In other words, Jesus came to Earth as a man, FULLY HUMAN, of His own free will. He
	never gave up His DIVINE NATURE, but He did temporarily LAY ASIDE HIS POWERS
