| Definition: "The SPIRIT HELPS in our WEAKNESSES" - "Weakness" in this context means our INABILITY to KNOW EXACTLY HOW WE SHOULD PRAY. The Holy Spirit helps us in our praying when we really get SERIOUS about prayer. This is not talking about the selfish or foolish requests we sometimes ask of God (see James 4:2-3), but when we are sincere and earnest , we don't have to worry about "not praying correctly" or "following a certain prayer formula" - The Holy Spirit HIMSELF will make any CORRECTIONS NECESSARY, and PRESENT OUR PRAYERS before the Father (make intercession for us). | | |
| Definition: "GROANINGS which cannot be UTTERED" - "Utter" means to express in words. When the Holy Spirit PRAYS FOR US, He does it WITHOUT WORDS that we can hear. There are times when we pray, when we cannot find the words, but our heart is crying out to God for a particular situation, or on behalf of someone else. The Holy Spirit is praying for us and with us at such times. | | |

The Holy Spirit "comes along side to help," but Jesus is DEFENDING and PROTECTING us by His intercessory PRAYER for us, and as our MEDIATOR, He has opened the way for us to come directly into God's presence. |
