Definition: "SUCH were SOME of YOU" – We ALL have a PAST life, before we were saved, that includes sinful behavior. It is only by the BLOOD of JESUS CHRIST that we are forgiven and CLEANSED of those sins. A person who has NOT trusted Jesus Christ for salvation and forgiveness of their sins has NO PART in the kingdom of God. Jesus said, "Unless a man is BORN AGAIN, he cannot [even] SEE the Kingdom of God" (John 3:3). Since God says He has WASHED us, and He has SANCTIFIED us (made us holy), and He has JUSTIFIED us (removed our sins from us) through the working of His Holy Spirit, HOW foolish can we be to go back into sinful behavior as if it didn't mean anything?
