Titus Bible Study — Titus 3:4-8 Lesson #5

****INSTRUCTIONS:** Read the entire section of Scripture in Titus before starting to look up the other Scripture verses and filling in the blanks. Pray and ask the Holy Spirit to give you understanding as you read God’s word. Most Scriptures used are from the New King James Version.

4-6 But when the **KINDNESS and the LOVE of God our Savior** toward man appeared, **NOT by works of righteousness which we have done**, but according to His **MERCY He SAVED us**, through the **WASHING of REGENERATION** and renewing of the Holy Spirit, whom He poured out on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior.

Definition: “The KINDNESS and the LOVE of God our Savior” – God’s motivation for SAVING us and doing all the wonderful things He does for us is His KINDNESS and LOVE. In the Old Testament the word “lovingkindness” is often used, and the Hebrew word is “hesed” which means unfailling love, goodness, kindness, devotion. These would be **some of the characteristics of God:** His kindness, His compassion, His tenderness in CARING for His people, **His mercy in NOT punishing us for our sins**, and His GRACE in GIVING US the BLESSINGS we DO NOT deserve. We, as Believers in Jesus Christ, are to demonstrate these same characteristics, and they are called **the FRUIT of the SPIRIT**. No, we can’t have these characteristics in ourselves and in our own power, **we need the HOLY SPIRIT and His power** to produce this fruit in our lives.

Definition: “By GRACE you have been SAVED” — Grace means God’s **FAVOR or love and**

acceptance given to us WITHOUT our doing ANYTHING!! **We cannot earn our salvation or pay for it or work for it!!** **Grace** is God giving us GOOD THINGS we DON'T deserve, and **MERCY** is God **NOT GIVING** us the **punishment we DO DESERVE**. It is because of "**The KINDNESS and the LOVE of God our Savior**" that He shows us His grace and MERCY in order to save us poor, sinful human beings.

Definition: "He SAVED us, through the WASHING of REGENERATION" – Many things happen to us spiritually at the moment we are saved, and one of them is that **we are WASHED from our sins in the blood of Jesus**. "**REGENERATION**" is just a big word for being BORN AGAIN.

Definition: "He cannot SEE the kingdom of God" — Jesus lets Nicodemus (and everyone else) know that it is NOT the keeping of laws, commandments, ordinances, rules, regulations or ANY OUTWARD CONDUCT that makes a person RIGHTEOUS and WORTHY to be a part of God's Kingdom. It must be **an INWARD CHANGE, a NEW BIRTH, a NEW CREATION by GOD** of a COMPLETELY NEW PERSON, for someone to be a part of His Kingdom.

Definition: "The POOR in SPIRIT" — This means being HUMBLE, having HUMILITY, the opposite of PRIDE. What does this have to do with Jesus saying a person must be born again? Because no one can come to Jesus by faith and be born again, unless they are "**poor in spirit**" or **humble, and admit that they cannot earn their way to heaven**. This would be the hardest part for someone like Nicodemus, because he thought he already had it made with God.

Definition: “BORN of WATER and the SPIRIT” — Water is used in scripture to represent the Holy Spirit and the word of God. Since Jesus already mentions the Holy Spirit in this verse, we can assume **the “water” means the word of God.** This is NOT talking about water baptism, because **water baptism is only SYMBOLIC of God’s washing and cleansing us** when we are BORN AGAIN. God washes and cleanses us from our SINS by **His word, the Holy Spirit, and the blood of Jesus.**

Definition: “He cannot ENTER the kingdom of God” — The reason a person CANNOT enter the kingdom of God without being born again, is because **we are all DEAD in our SINS**, and we MUST have a SPIRITUAL RE-BIRTH and be RE-CREATED and given LIFE by God in order to **LIVE in His kingdom.**

Definition: “JUSTIFIED” — Justification or the **ACT of being justified** means that God by His **GRACE declares RIGHTEOUS** the sinner who believes on Jesus Christ. It is **NOT a process of becoming** righteous, it is a **ONE-TIME ACT of GRACE** — we are **MADE RIGHTEOUS** the moment

we accept Jesus as our Savior! It is NOT merely FORGIVENESS, although forgiveness is INCLUDED — God does indeed FORGIVE AND FORGET OUR SINS. However, **JUSTIFICATION means God even FORGETS THAT WE WERE EVER SINNERS!** There is NO MORE RECORD of our sins.

Definition: “We should become HEIRS” and “JOINT HEIRS with Christ” — An HEIR is one who will inherit or receive some endowment, property or quality from a PARENT. We are God’s children, so we are also His HEIRS. JOINT HEIRS means **we will INHERIT EQUALLY with Jesus.**

Definition: “Those who have BELIEVED should be CAREFUL to MAINTAIN GOOD WORKS”

– What place do “good works” have in our lives? We are saved by **GRACE through our FAITH** (Eph. 2:8-9), and **NOT by our works** or by keeping the Old Testament Law, but our good works are the **PRODUCT** of our salvation, and a **testimony** to unbelievers to **SHOW** them that we belong to the Lord. God also uses us, as we do “good deeds” and acts of charity (love) **to help meet the needs** of His people in the church body.
