Definition: “Do NOT LAY HANDS on anyone HASTILY” – The laying on of hands was a major part of the service or ordaining pastors and of any kind of sending missionaries into the foreign field, etc. (many times accompanied by fasting and prayer) **Paul is warning Timothy to NOT send someone off into any kind of special ministry hastily, or in other words, DON'T be in a HURRY to do it.** Timothy (and any other pastor or church leader) should wait and see if the life of this person is really Christlike, or else **they may become “SHARERS in other people's sins.”** For instance, you don't want to let a man be involved in children's ministry if he has a record of child molesting, or even if there is no criminal record, you should observe that man to make sure he does not act in any kind of improper way when around children.

Definition: PARTAKE — to share or participate in; to take part in something. Rather than being PARTAKERS in the SIN and CORRUPTION of this world, God allows us to be PARTAKERS of His DIVINE NATURE.

Definition: “Use a LITTLE WINE for your stomach’s sake” – The Bible does not say we can never drink wine, **God just says NOT to get DRUNK on it** (or any other alcoholic beverage or drug).

Evidently, Timothy had some stomach problems, and **a LITTLE wine, used for medicinal purposes**, might help. Drinking water in those days might be polluted or dirty, so many people drank wine as a regular part of their daily meals.

Definition: “That the NAME of GOD and His doctrine may not be BLASPHEMED” – To blaspheme means to speak evil of; to speak irreverently or profanely, especially of God or sacred things; to curse or revile.

• **Romans 2:24** “For ‘The name of God is _____ among the Gentiles because of _____,’ as it is written.”

Definition: “As many SERVANTS as are under the YOKE” – A yoke was a large wooden bar that would go over the shoulders of oxen, horses or mules to have them pull a wagon or a plow. A smaller version of the yoke would go over the shoulders of a man or woman, usually with two buckets on each end of the yoke for hauling water. **Paul uses this idea of a YOKE to speak of those who were slaves.** To be a slave to another person was a kind of bondage or BURDEN (heavy weight) to carry, both physical and psychological. **Jesus tells us that HIS YOKE is easy, and His burden is light (not heavy).** Even if a person is a physical, actual slave to another person, he or she can be FREE and NOT be under a heavy burden if they are trusting in Jesus Christ.
