Definition: "the GLORY which I HAD WITH YOU BEFORE the WORLD WAS" - Jesus existed with God the Father and the Holy Spirit from all eternity. There is not a time when Jesus came into being, except that He came down from heaven to be born as a man, and in that case, **His HUMAN existence has a beginning.** Jesus, as the "Word" of God and the Second Person of the Godhead (Trinity), created everything that is in existence, and **He shared the glory of the Father** "before the world was." Obviously, if He created the world, He had to be here "BEFORE the world was."

Definition: "GLORIFY" - To honor, praise, extol and magnify God. To acknowledge God as to His being, His attributes (qualities), and His acts.

Definition: "GOD'S GLORY" - The revelation and manifestation of all that God is: His goodness, His mercy, His judgment, His everlasting power and divinity. His glory is what God essentially is and does as manifested (exhibited) in whatever way He reveals Himself. **Moses asked God to show him His GLORY**, and God passed by Moses and proclaimed His own qualities of goodness and mercy. Also associated with the presence of God going before the Israelites in a cloud and pillar of fire, as the **LIGHT or BRIGHTNESS of His GLORY.** In the Old Testament, this is called "The Shekinah." Jesus is called "Emmanuel," which means "God with us", the PRESENCE of God among men. Jesus also said that **He is "the Light of the World"** (John 8:12), which means **He is that Shekinah GLORY of God** among men (See Ezekiel 10:4 & 18; 11:22-23; Ezekiel 43:1-7; Exodus 33:17-23; II Chronicles 5:13-14; Numbers 9:15).

Definition: "I have MANIFESTED Your NAME" - To manifest means to reveal, to show, to exhibit in a way which can be seen, to declare, to display. **Jesus came to DECLARE and SHOW who God is** in a way that could be understood by men. God's "name" means His qualities, characteristics, and essential being.

- **John 1:18** "No one has _____ God at any time. The only begotten _____, who is in the bosom of the Father, He has _____ Him."

Definition : "IN THE BOSOM of the Father" - This is an expression of the closeness and intimacy that Jesus has ALWAYS HAD with the Father. This verse also says Jesus IS (present tense) "In the bosom of" the Father, which indicates the OMNIPRESENCE of Jesus as GOD the SON. He could be here on earth in a physical body, and STILL be PRESENT WITH the FATHER in heaven at the same time.

- **John 5:17-23** "But Jesus answered them, 'My _____ has been working until now, and I have been working.' Therefore the Jews sought all the more to _____ Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that _____ was His _____, making Himself _____ with God. Then Jesus answered and said to them, 'Most assuredly, I say to you, the _____ can do nothing of Himself, but what He _____ the _____ do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner. For the Father loves the Son, and _____ Him all things that He Himself does;

Definition: "No one has SEEN GOD" - No one has ever actually seen **God in His divine ESSENCE or FACE TO FACE**. In the Old Testament, a few people "saw God," but it was either a VISION of God on His throne (see Ezekiel 1:1 & 1:26-28, Isaiah 6:1-6, Daniel 7:9-14), or they saw a PORTION of God's glory as Moses did (see Exodus 33:17-23), or they saw the pre-incarnate Jesus, as did Abraham, who saw the Lord in appearance as a man (see Genesis 18:1-22. The other "two men" were angels - see Gen. 19:1). We, as sinful beings, cannot stand in God's presence, we would be burned up in an instant by His glory. Only by **BEING BORN of the SPIRIT** are we **re-created into a being** who will be able to be in God's very PRESENCE for all eternity.

Definition: "the ONLY BEGOTTEN SON" - **Jesus is the only begotten Son, or UNIQUE, one-of-a-kind Son of God**, in that He is the EXACT IMAGE of God, and that He existed in this SON RELATIONSHIP with the Father for all eternity. No one else can become a son of God in the same sense as Jesus (**JESUS is GOD in the FLESH**), but we can become sons and daughters of God, and be born into His family BY FAITH in Jesus Christ.

- **John 1:12** "But as many as _____ Him, to them He gave the right to become _____ of God, even to those who _____ in His _____."

Definition: "I have GIVEN to them the WORDS which YOU have GIVEN ME" - Jesus **deliberately LIMITED HIMSELF** to doing ONLY what the FATHER SHOWED HIM, and **speaking only the WORDS the Father gave Him**. Jesus, as the second Person of the Godhead, existed from all eternity and could do ANYTHING He wanted, but He CHOSE to come to earth in human form and be OBEDIENT to the Father.

Definition: "I do not PRAY for the WORLD" - The world in this sense is **the evil world SYSTEM under the control of Satan**. Satan is called "the god of this world" and the "prince" or "ruler" **of this WORLD**. Jesus is saying that God the Father has called us OUT of this evil world, and now we belong to Him.

Definition: "PRINCE of the POWER of the AIR" - This is one of the many **names or titles for Satan** in the Bible. Satan is called the "prince of the power of the AIR" because he and his demons inhabit the atmosphere or AIR around us. We were **motivated** and energized by Satan when we were "children of disobedience", before we were saved. **All unsaved people** belong to **Satan** and are under his control in one way or another.
