Definition: "It shall NOT COME NEAR you" – This is a precious promise from God's word, especially since it does not say what the "it" is - it could be anything that is causing you to be afraid. The "thousands" that are falling all around you refers to non-believers, while **the Believer who is TRUSTING in the Lord will be protected**.

Definition: "SEE the REWARD of the WICKED" – The "reward of wicked" means that those who hate God will be getting what they deserve. God's punishment may be delayed, according to our thinking, but He will punish the wicked for their deeds. If they do not repent and receive Christ, they will be punished for all eternity in HELL.

Definition: "You have **MADE the LORD..... even the Most High, your HABITATION**" – To make the Lord your habitation means the same as **ABIDING IN JESUS**. To **ABIDE** means to **DWELL**, and a **habitation** means a **place to dwell or live**. "The Most High" is another name for God. In the New Testament, Jesus says we must "abide in Him", and He will abide in us.

Definition: “TREAD upon the lion and the COBRA..... the SERPENT you shall TRAMPLE underfoot” – These are more promises of God’s protection, and I believe they apply to literal, physical snakes and poisonous things, but also to Satan and his demons, who are called “serpents and scorpions” in the Bible. For snakes and deadly or poisonous things here on earth, **we are NEVER to put ourselves deliberately in danger, but God will protect us if we come into contact with something by accident** (see Paul in Acts 28:3-6). As for Satan and his demons, EVERY true, born again Christian has AUTHORITY over them in our own lives, and in certain situations, to cast them out of others’ lives. The situations where you and I cannot cast demons out of someone else is when that person WANTS the demons to remain. That person has FREE WILL, and if they want the demons, we can’t cast them out.

Definition: “With LONG LIFE I will SATISFY him” – The average human life span has had its ups and downs over the centuries. Adam lived to be nine hundred and thirty years old (see Genesis 5:5), but because of the curse of sin, that life span has become less and less over the years until it is around 70-80 years now. By being obedient to God, we can ask Him to “satisfy” us with a longer life, especially if we are using that time here on earth to serve God.
